Haley McKibben sentenced to 15 years for role in 2015 murder, attempted robbery

(Indianapolis, Ind.) Marion County Prosecutor Terry Curry announced today that Haley McKibben pleaded guilty to Robbery Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury (Level 2 Felony) and received a 15-year sentence for her role in the March 2015 attempted robbery and murder of John Kinsey, Jr. Based on the sentence ordered today, McKibben will serve eight years in the Indiana Department of Correction, four years on Marion County Community Corrections and three years of the sentence was suspended.

On March 14, 2015, McKibben was responsible for setting up a robbery during which Julius Gordon shot and killed John Kinsey, Jr. Kinsey's body was found in a parked car on the city's west side. In February, a jury convicted Julius Gordon of the murder of John Kinsey, Jr. and he is serving a 55-year sentence in the Indiana Department of Correction.
