Six individuals sentenced in 2016 kidnapping, robbery on city's near southeast side

Two victims held in basement and beaten while forced to withdraw money from bank account

(Indianapolis, Ind.) Marion County Prosecutor Terry Curry announced that six suspects have been convicted and sentenced for their roles in the August 2016 kidnapping, assault and robbery of two people at a residence in the 1700 block of Pleasant Run Parkway South Drive. Meg Thompson, the final defendant to be sentenced in the case, was ordered to serve a 10-year sentence on Tuesday for her role in the crimes.

"We are pleased with the successful resolution to these cases," Prosecutor Curry stated. "The work of detectives and cooperation by the victims provided for five of the six defendants accepting responsibility for their roles and pleading guilty."

On August 1, 2016, the defendants had a male victim lure his former girlfriend to his home, then assaulted and robbed the pair. The two victims were held in a basement, bound at their wrists, legs and heads with zip ties and electrical cords, and assaulted over the course of several hours. During that time, the defendants used the vehicle of one victim and her bank cards to withdraw money from her accounts. Some of the defendants then drove the female victim to her bank to withdraw additional money. Both victims suffered various injuries as a result of the assault, including a fractured orbital bone on the female victim.

The following six individuals were convicted and sentenced in the crimes:

Jason Monohan was convicted at court trial in November 2016 of Robbery Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury (Level 2 Felony), two counts of Criminal Confinement (Level 3 Felony), and Kidnapping (Level 5 Felony). Monohan was sentenced to 45 years in the Indiana Department of Correction (IDOC).

Michael Bennett pleaded guilty in July to Robbery Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury (Level 3 Felony) and was sentenced to 25 years.

Katrina Grider pleaded guilty in June to Robbery Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury (Level 2 Felony) and Criminal Confinement (Level 3 Felony) and was sentenced to 25 years.

Anthony Doss pleaded guilty in January to Criminal Confinement (Level 3 Felony) and Robbery Resulting in Bodily Injury (Level 3 Felony) and received a sentence of 14 years.

Meg Thompson pleaded guilty on August 9 to Robbery Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury (Level 2 Felony) and Criminal Confinement (Level 3 Felony) and was ordered to serve nine years in the IDOC and one year on Marion County Community Corrections.

Albert Wilson pleaded guilty in March to Criminal Confinement (Level 6 Felony) and was sentenced to 910 days in Marion County Community Corrections on Work Release.
