

Mobile Food Regulation

Mobile Food Truck Operating Restrictions:

- Anyone operating a mobile food truck must comply with the operational requirements of the Food Vending Vehicle ordinance, Section 611-500 of the Revised Code for the Consolidated City of Indianapolis and Marion County (Revised Code).
- Cannot engage in selling food between the hours of 10 PM and 6 AM in the public right of way.
- Must vend food from the curb and not the street side of the vehicle.
- Mobile food trucks may operate on **private property** between 10 PM and 6 AM.
 - Must obtain a transient merchant license from the Department of Code Enforcement pursuant to Section 987 of the Revised Code.
