

## **RFQ ADDENDUM**

Brownfield Redevelopment Program – RFQ BRP-2018-001  
Professional Environmental Services for Implementation of EPA Assessment Grant  
*February 14, 2018*

### **Clarifications:**

- ***Is grant funding split between Hazardous Substances and Petroleum Compounds?***

This \$300,000 EPA Assessment grant is split between \$150,000 for sites with Hazardous Substances, and \$150,000 for sites with Petroleum Compounds.

- ***Can WBE/MBE/VBE/DOBE certification from other cities or States count towards fulfillment of the disadvantaged business enterprise goals stated in the RFQ?***

Firms wishing to be recognized as qualified disadvantaged business enterprises for the purposes of this project must be certified as such with the City of Indianapolis through the Office of Minority & Women Business Development. This also applies to firms proposed to act as subcontractors as part of a project team.

- ***Is the Property Insurance requirement listed on p.5 relating to Installation/Builder's Risk Insurance applicable to this project?***

The City is not requiring firms to already have or to obtain that type of insurance on this project.
