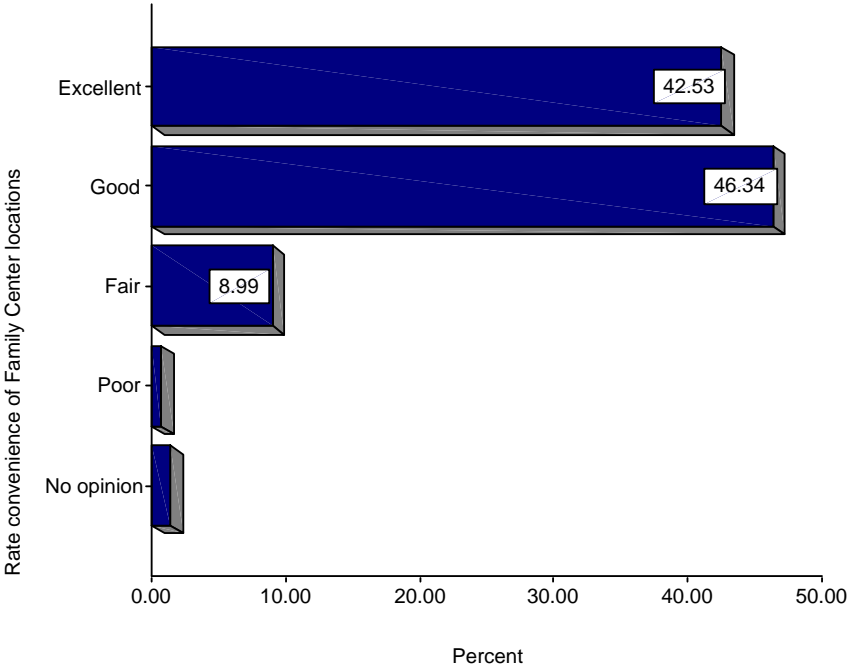

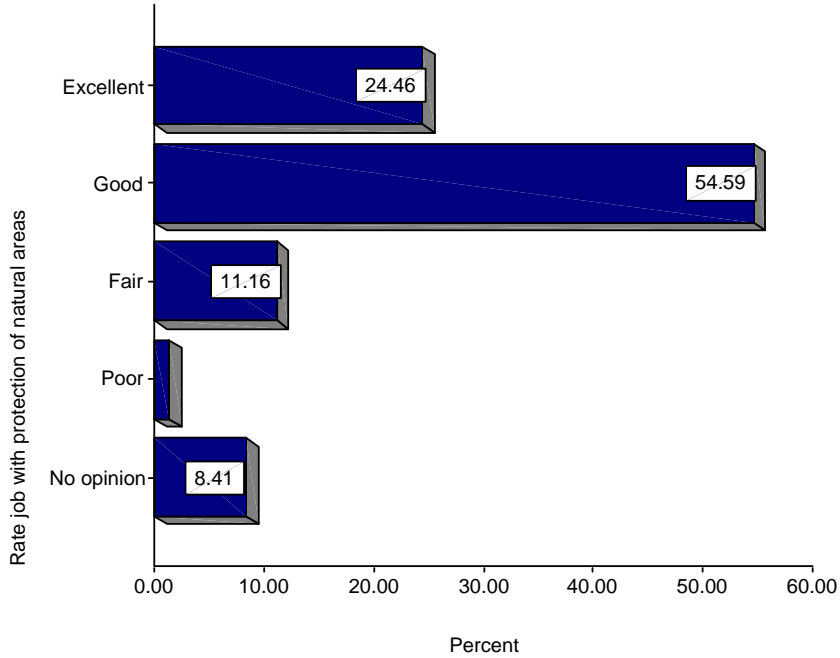

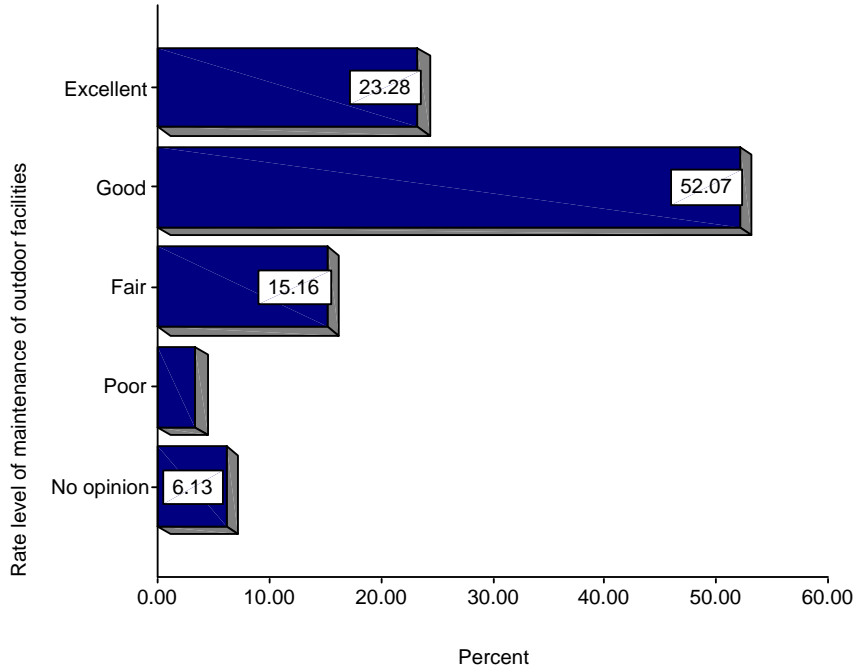

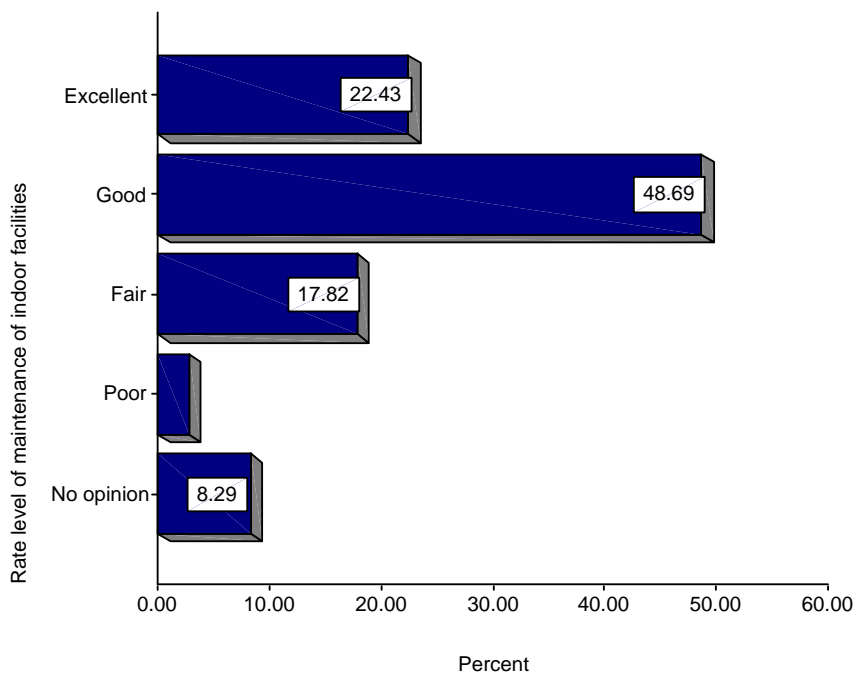

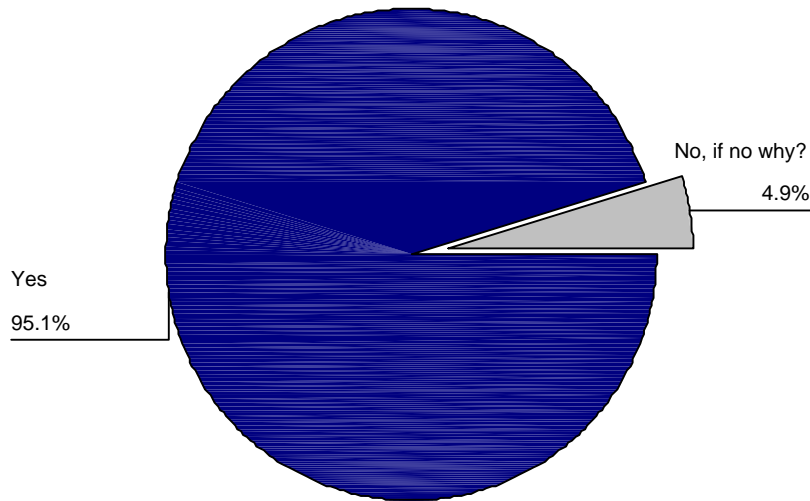

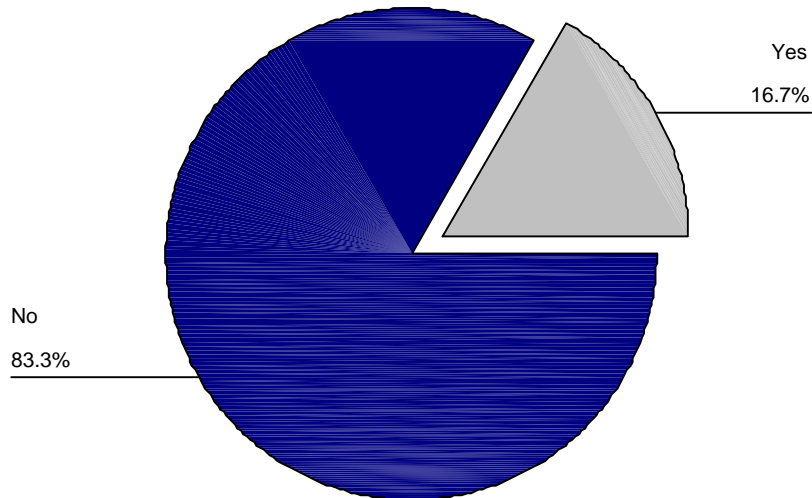


Reasons why respondents feel Family Centers are not safe.

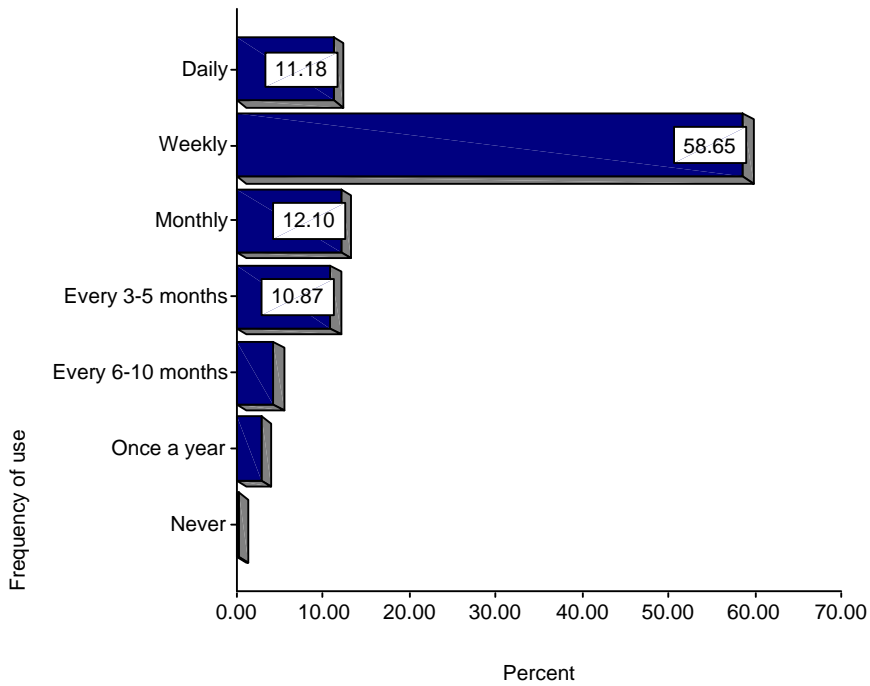

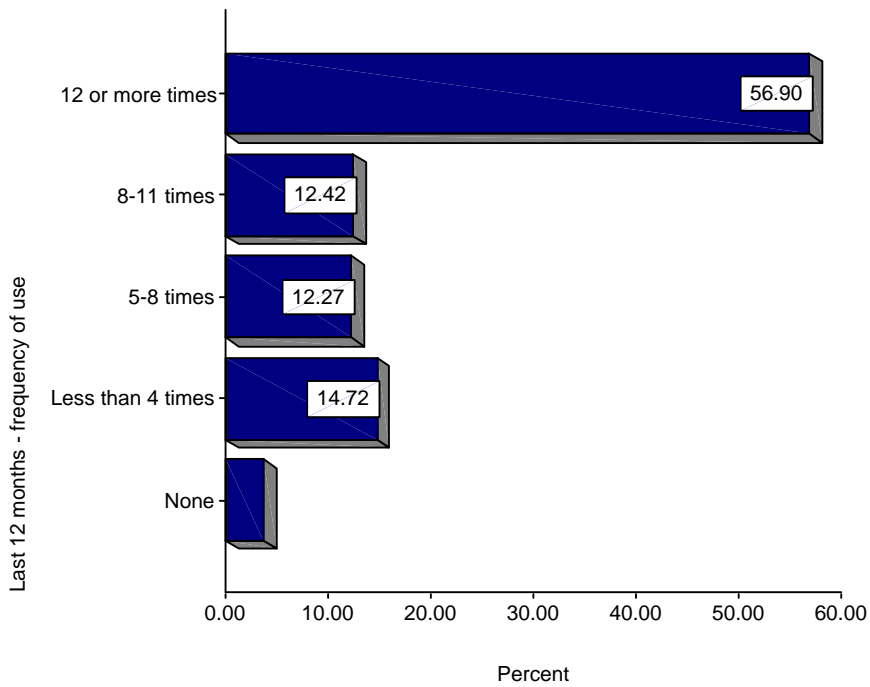

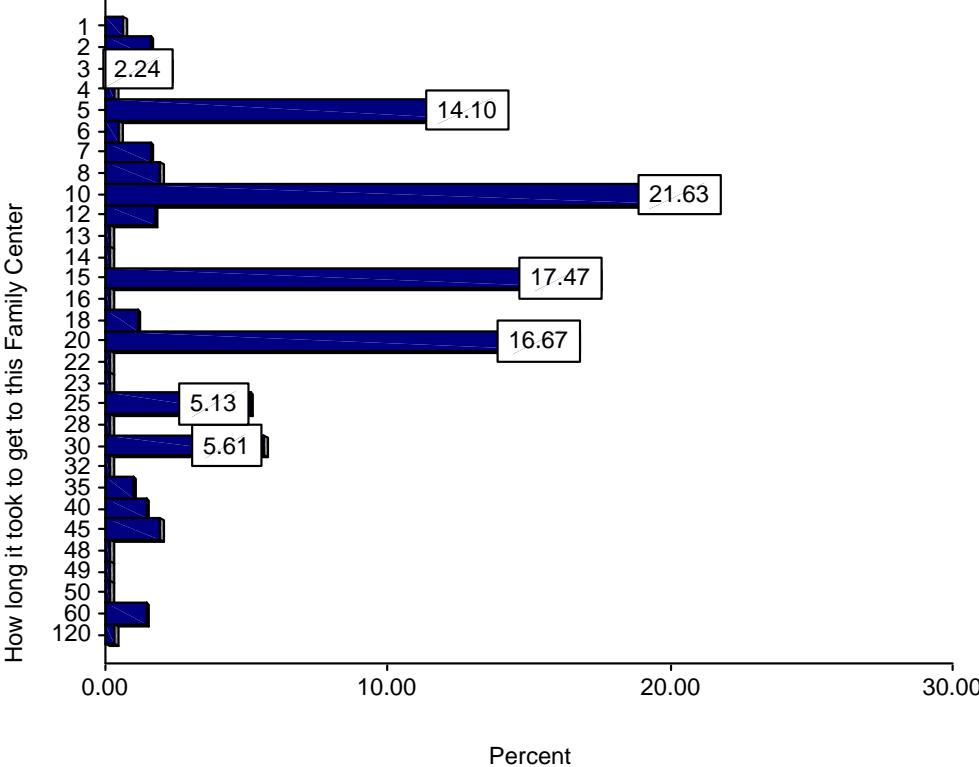

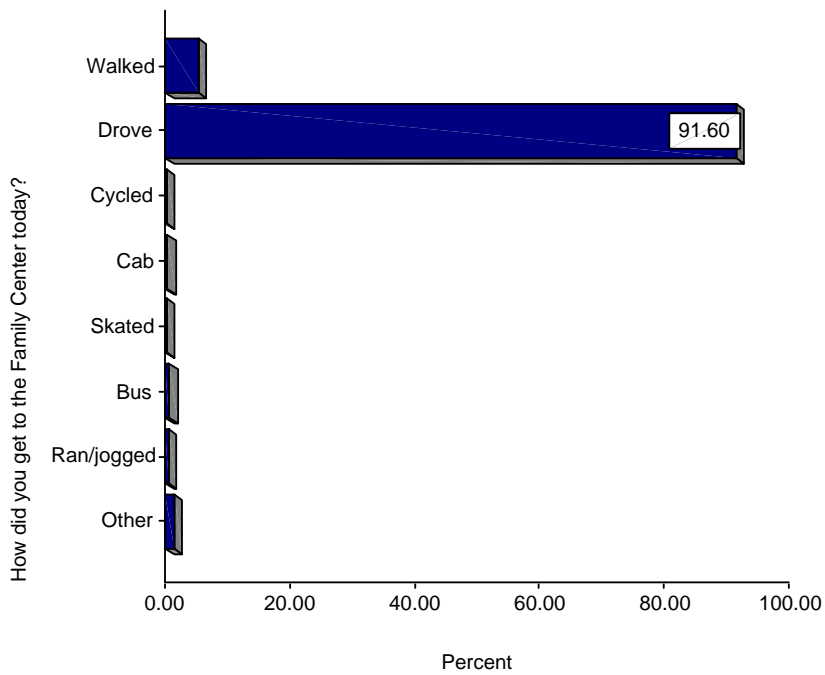

How long did it take you to get to the Family Center today? (minutes)?



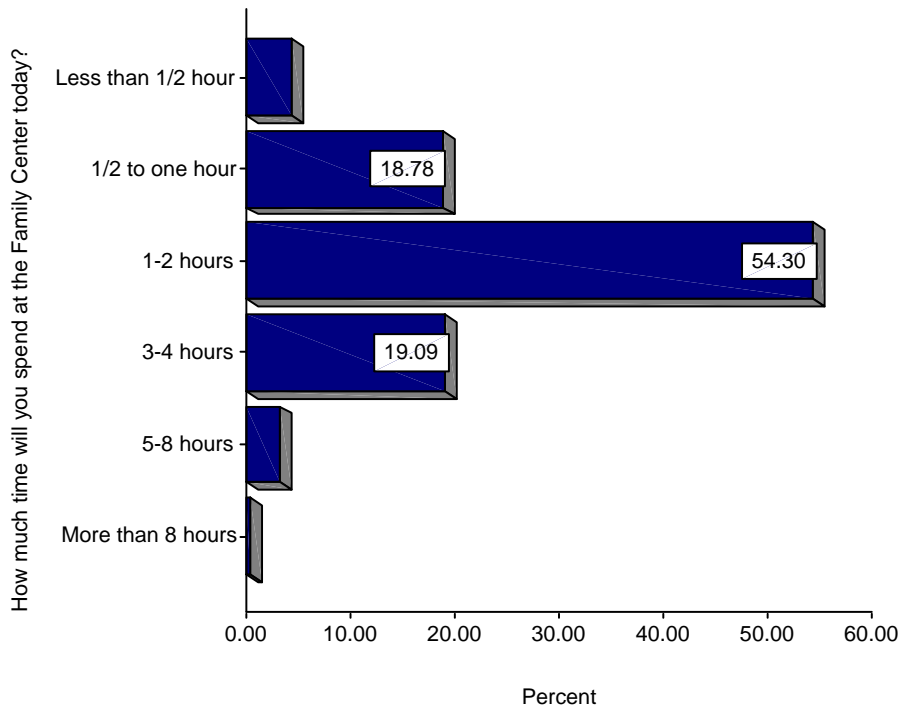

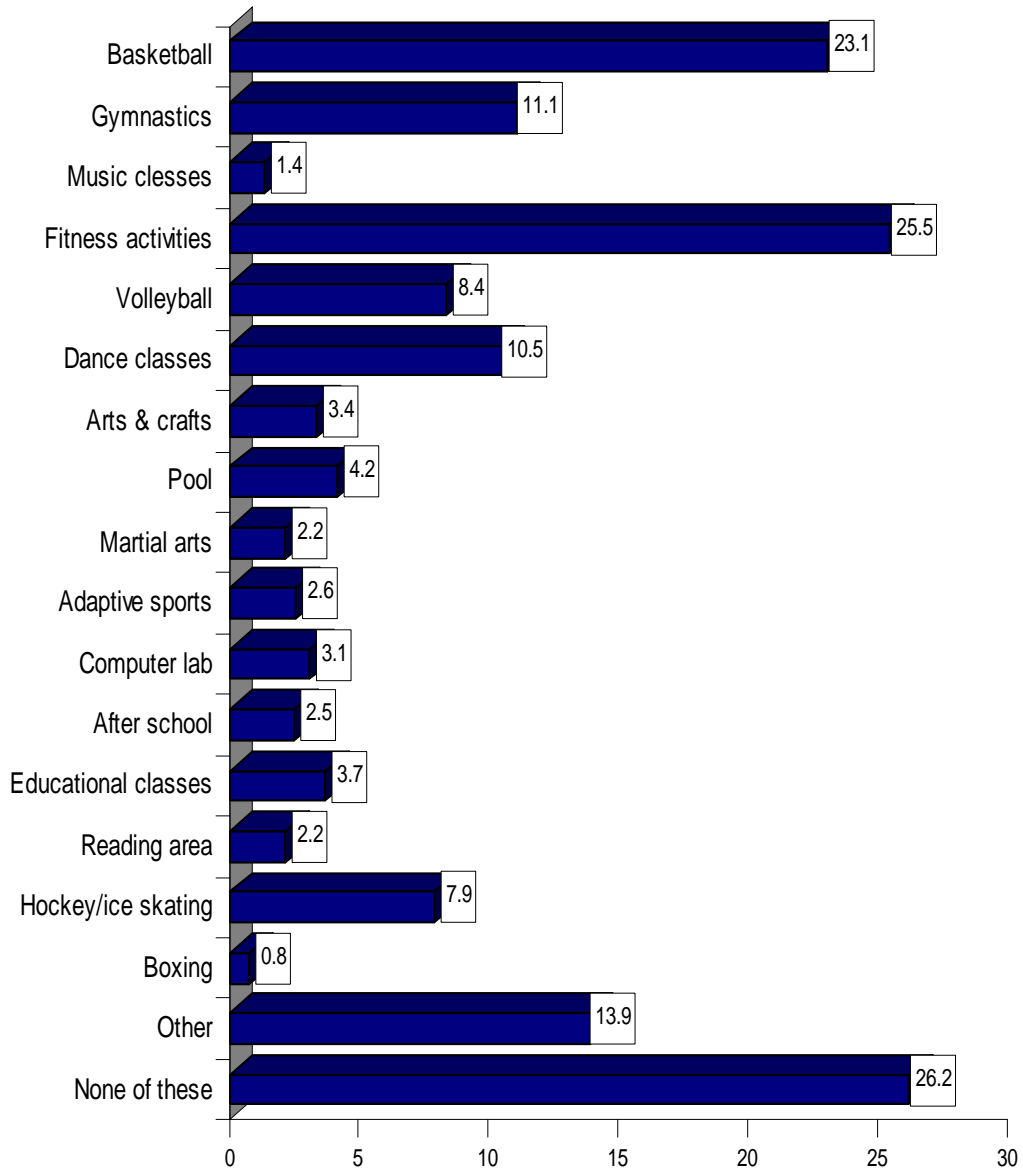

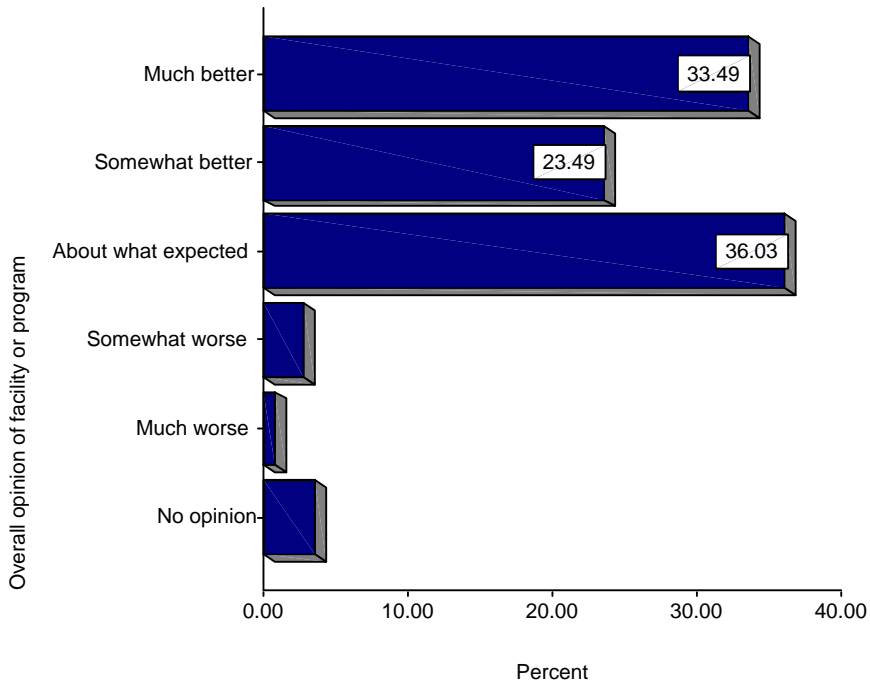

Relative to your expectations, what is your overall opinion of the facility or program you plan use today?

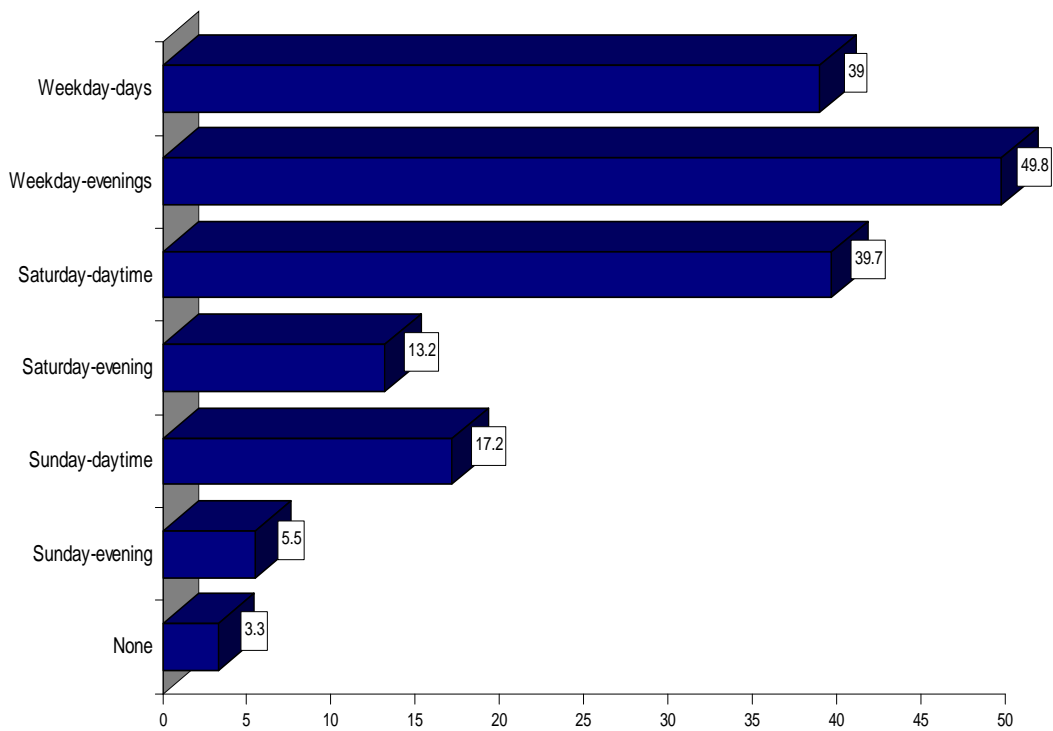

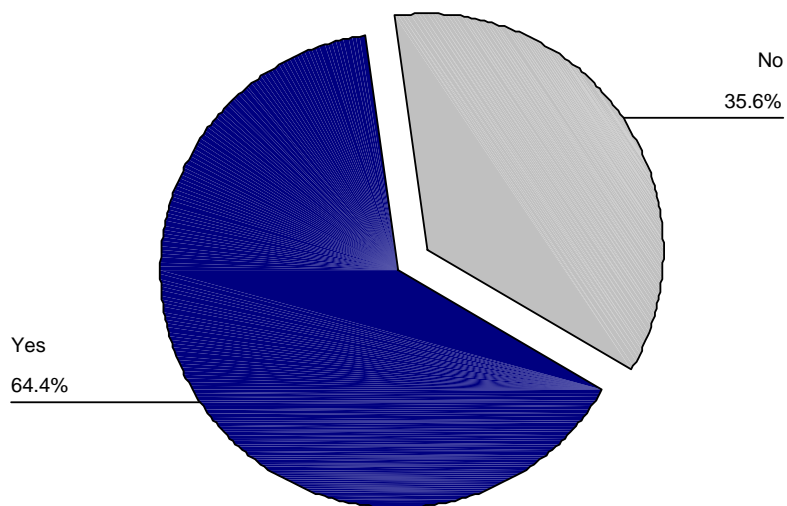

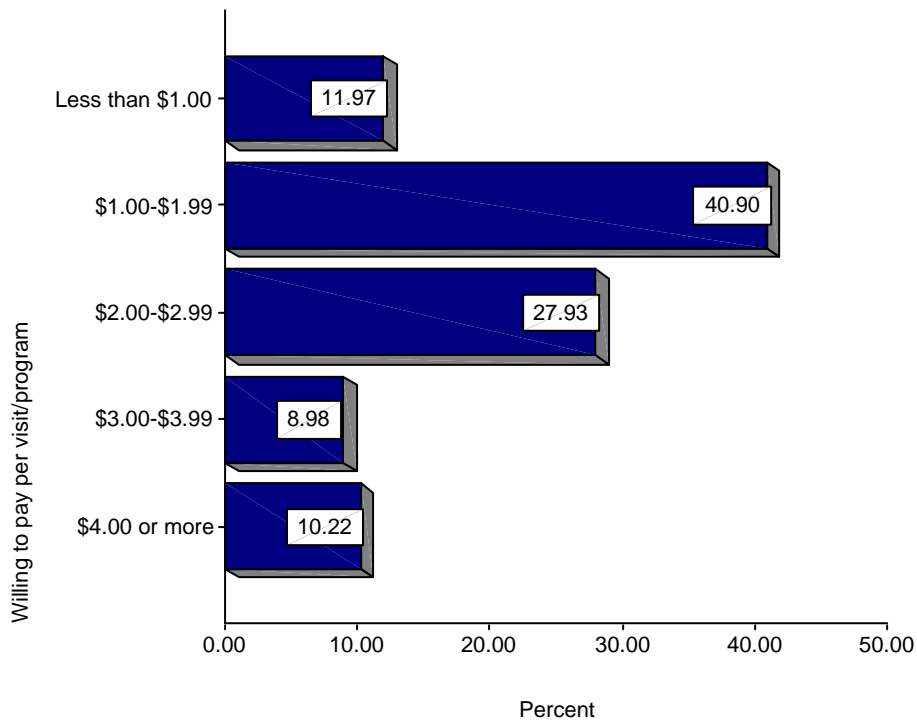
Would you be willing to pay more to use a park facility if it meant more programs and expanded hours?

If yes, how much more would you be willing to pay per visit or program?

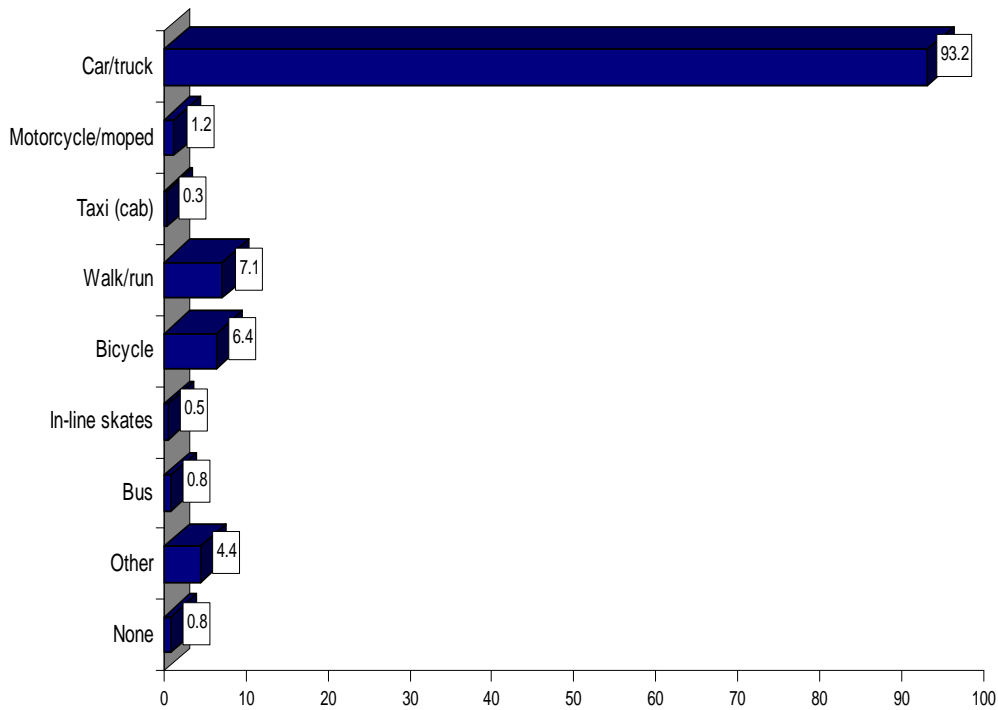

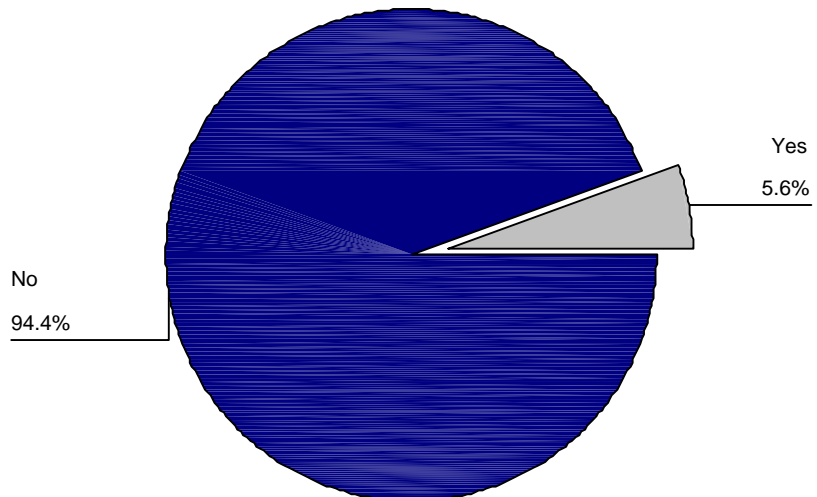
