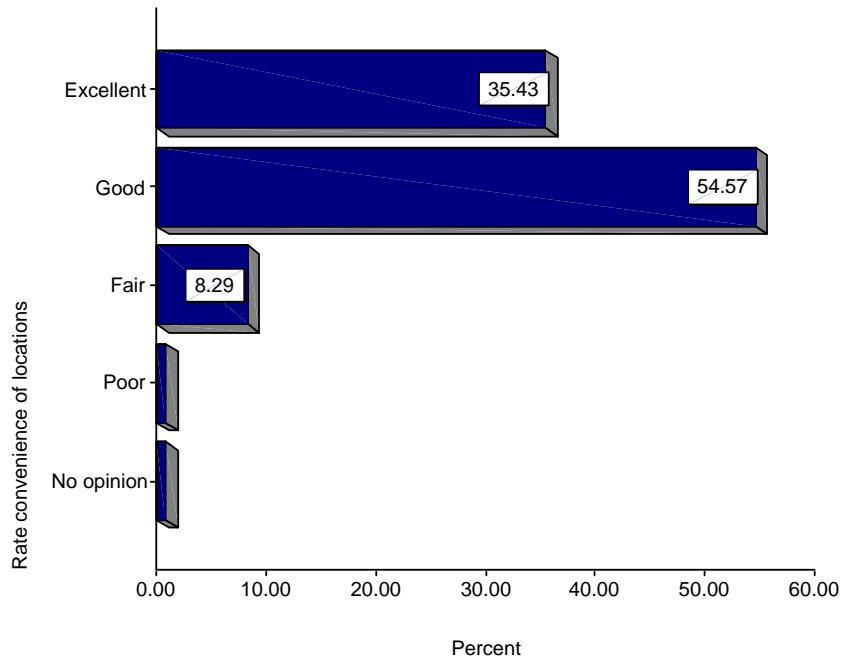

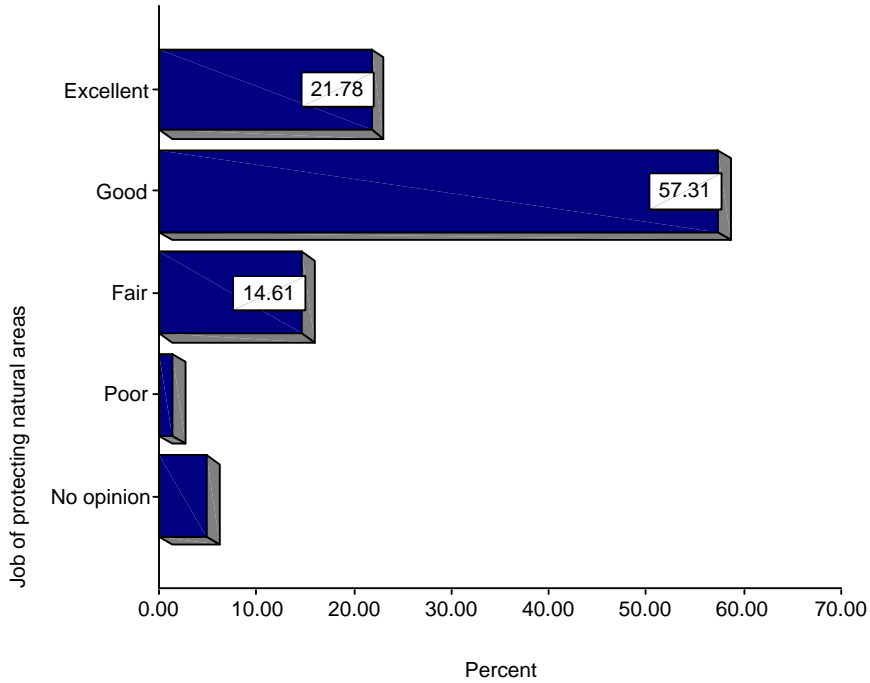

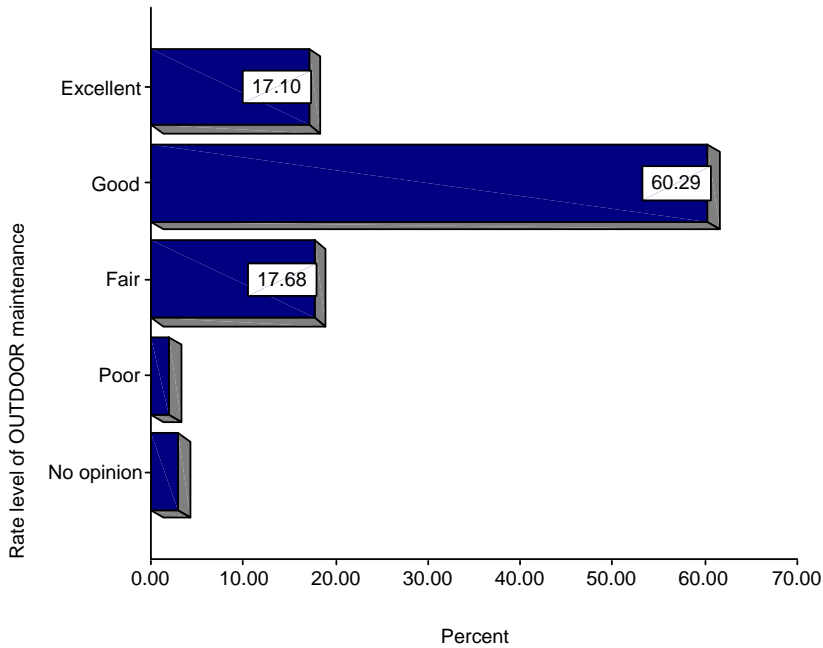


How would you rate the level of maintenance of parkland, outdoor sports field/courts, shelters, playgrounds, trails, or other OUTDOOR features in Indy Parks?

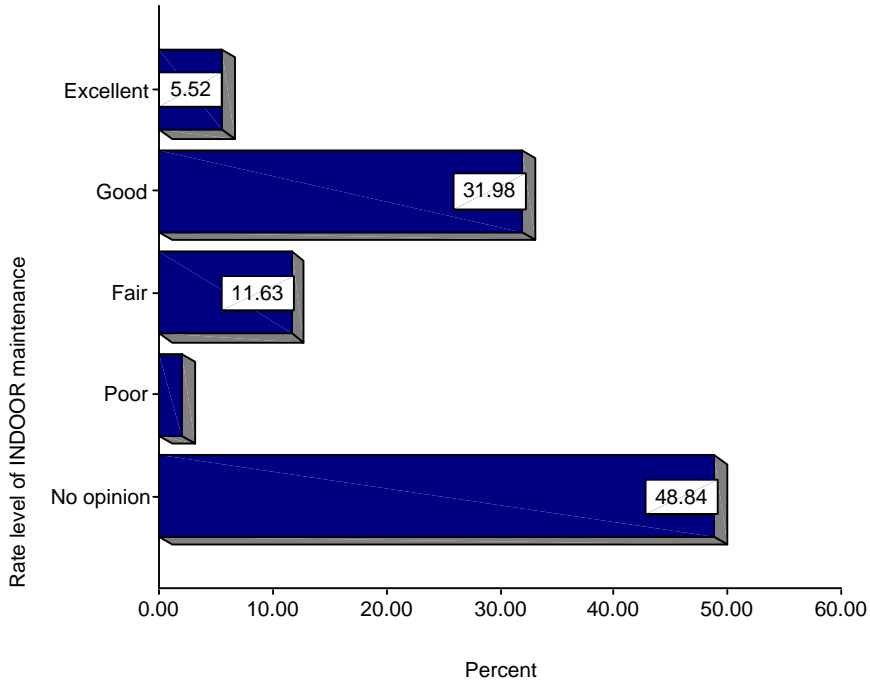

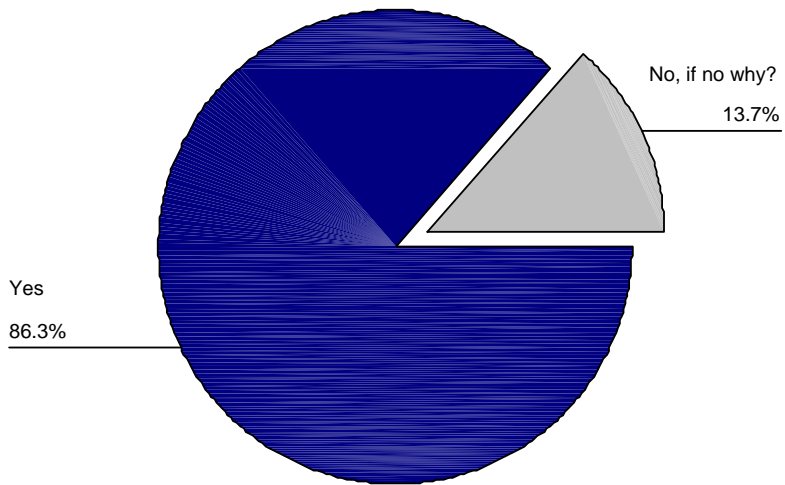

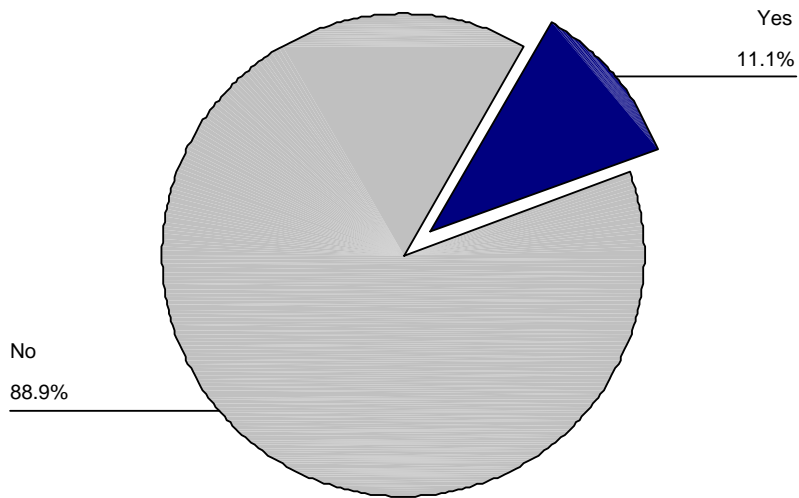


Why Indy Parks & Greenway/trails are not safe for people to use.

Too much crime between Broad Ripple & downtown-depends on location, Too many muggings on trail, South of 52nd street fewer people are out at night, We live at 20th Street & won't use the trail after 4 or 5-if we do we are very careful, Live downtown by the Monon & there are problems in that area-I wish you had more funding, so public-not always safe for women, Downtown area-still unsafe-frequent muggings, Depends on location, In bad area you need police, South of Broad Ripple-quite dangerous on trail, Can't use Monon south of 38th Street, Well-from Broad Ripple to Carmel it is safe, Heard stories that south side trails are sketchy-north side trails are great, Lights-patrols, Attacks on Monon, No patrols, South Monon could be improved-bike patrols would help, I am concerned with reports of problems, Generally safe-need to work on this, If they patrolled better, Clearly its difficult to provide 24/7 protection against the criminal elements, There are either dim or no lights along trails for us who ride home at night, People getting mugged on the Monon at night, Biking trails damaged-no emergency communication south of 38th on Monon, Unless it is after dark, Instances of crime are actually statistically low, Depends on if the person walking the trail is an idiot, Besides some instances when the phones don't work on the Monon, Crowded, The emergency phone down past 38th Street need to be working, There does need to be some patrolling on scooter or ATV, Yes-except for a few more attacks on Monon, Of course there are security problems on the Monon especially at certain times and in certain areas but I don't know if this is a problem for the park service or the police, I'm not from the area & the first thing I heard was about a biker getting assaulted, Not at dusk-my daughter has had problems while walking on trail after dusk/dark, If in day light-not after, In the day light, During high traffic times, Nothing is fail safe, Need more lights for evenings & more emergency boxes, More light and water fountains, No lights-need street lights on park trails (2), Our bike trailer was stolen at Canterbury last fall-will not stay if we are the only ones here, For the most part except the Monon in certain areas, Lighting is poor in some areas, Safe north of 38th Street-need more patrols with cops on bikes, During weekday mornings Monon south of 38th not safe to go alone, Safe north of 38th street, More lights & patrols would be helpful-as would buttons to change lights for crosswalks at roads, During the day, I wouldn't use early or late, Need more emergency phones, Recent safety issues on the Monon, Trails need more patrols, During day-not evening, There are problems especially on the Monon, Most but not all, Sometimes, Crime rate along 38th Street, Dawn to dusk only, Not in bad areas or secluded spots, Not always, Too dark, Loose dogs, Took my child there & someone was using heroine on a bench, Crime & violence, I live off the Monon & there seems to be a few attacks lately, Not at night-needs more light, Security-unkept weeds hide paths-equipment not safe enough for children, Not enough police, During the daytime, Not after dark, Too much crime, Monon safety concerns

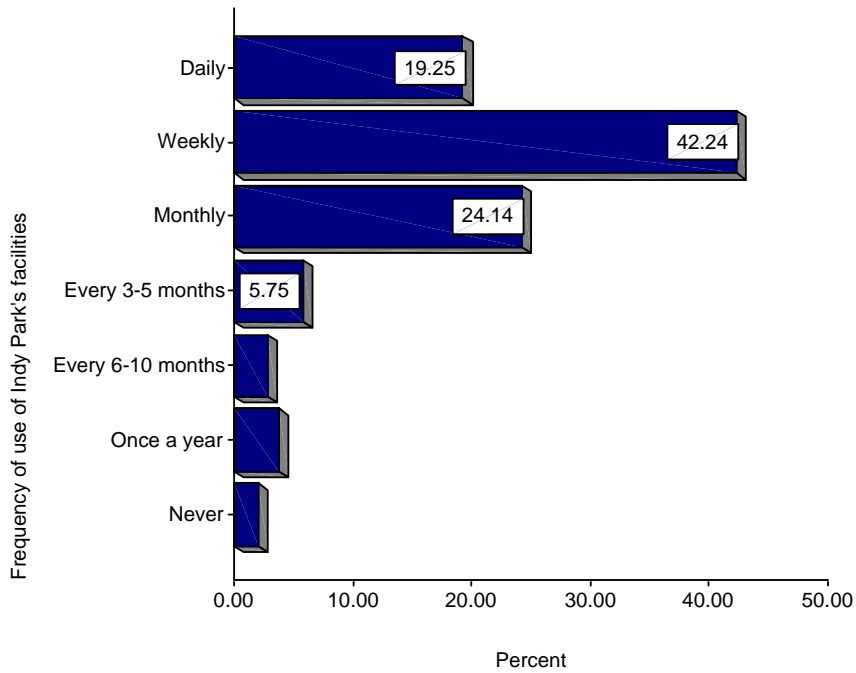

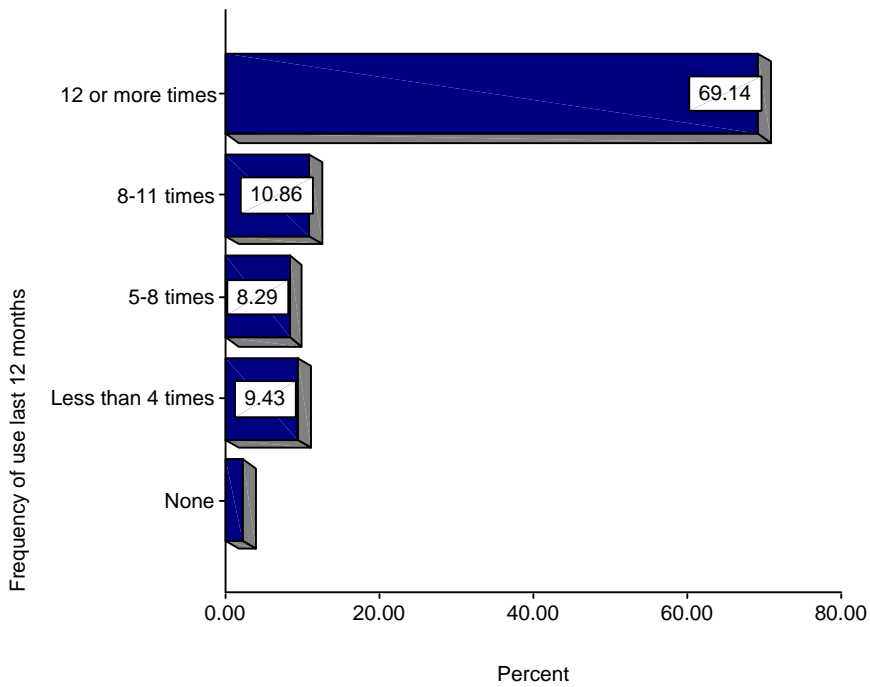

In the last 12 months, how many time have you, or any member of your household, used any park, open space, facility, greenway or trail?

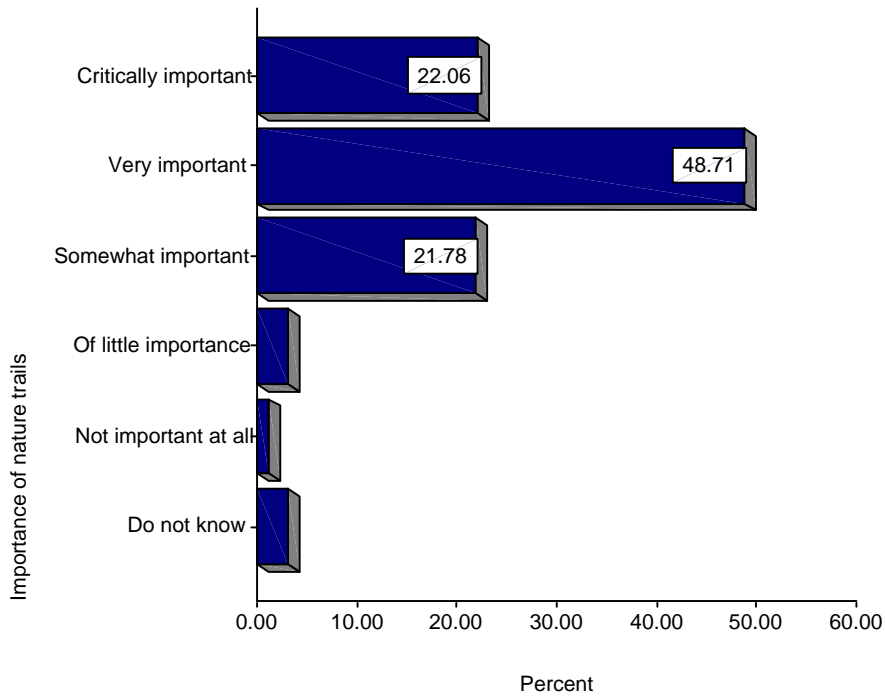

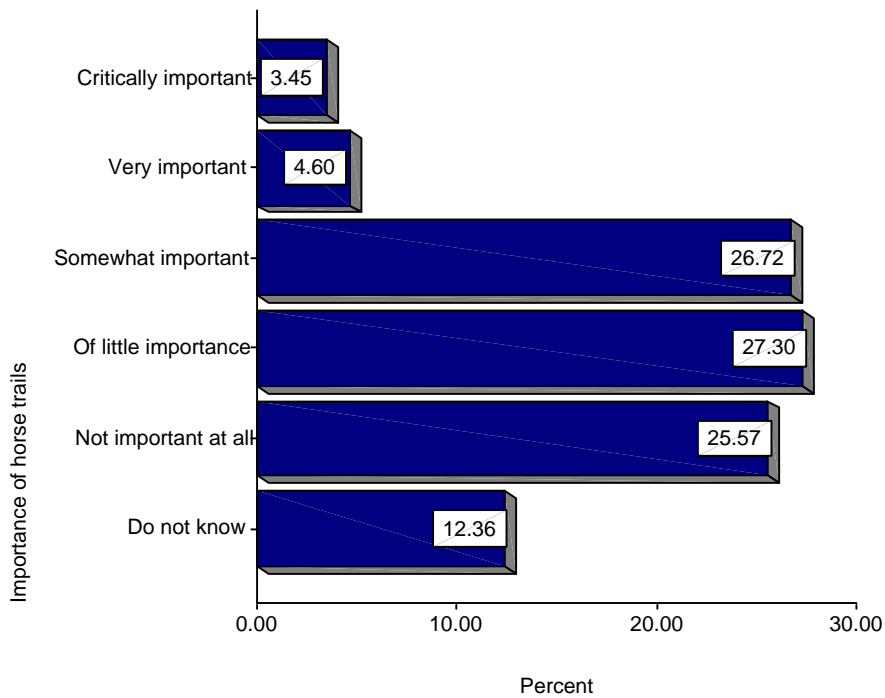

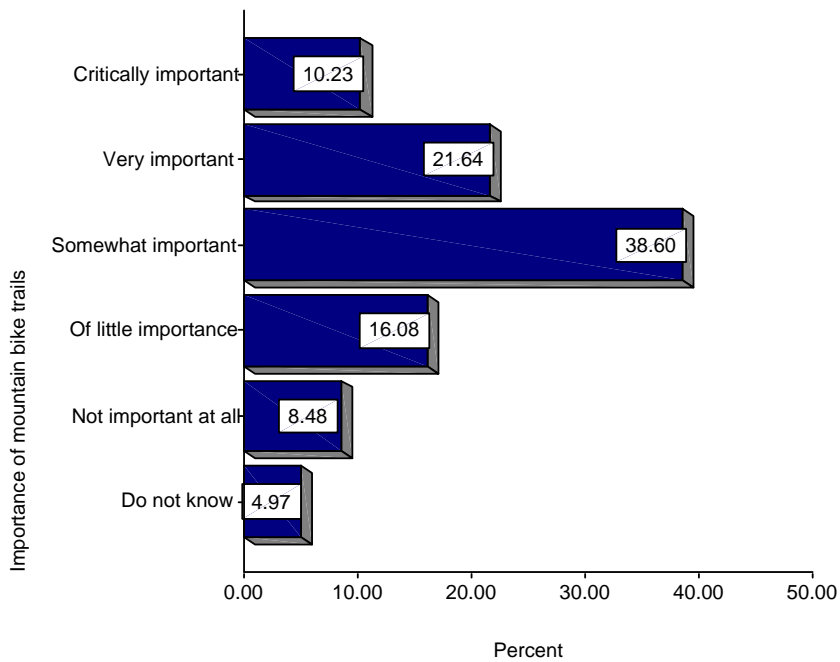

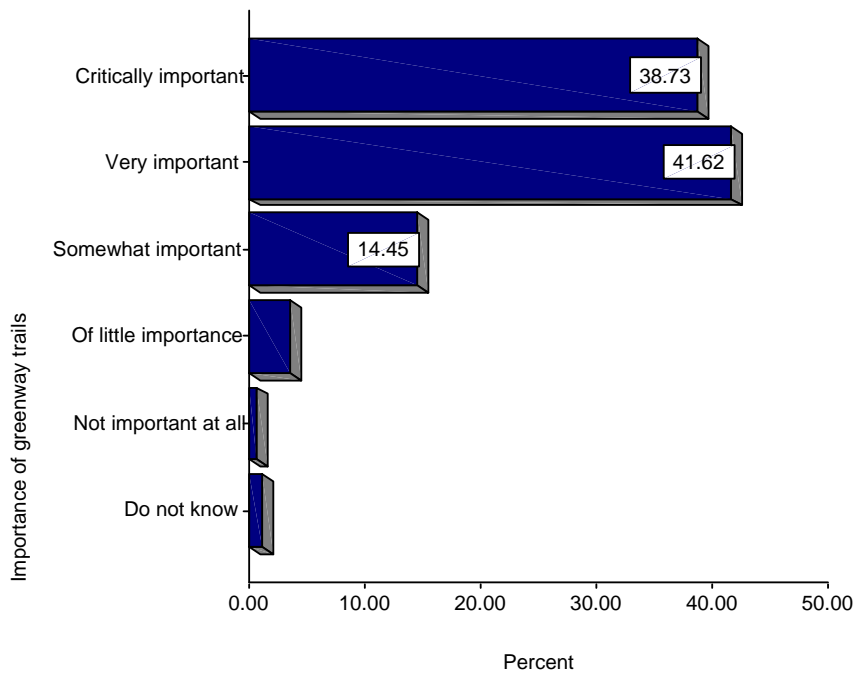

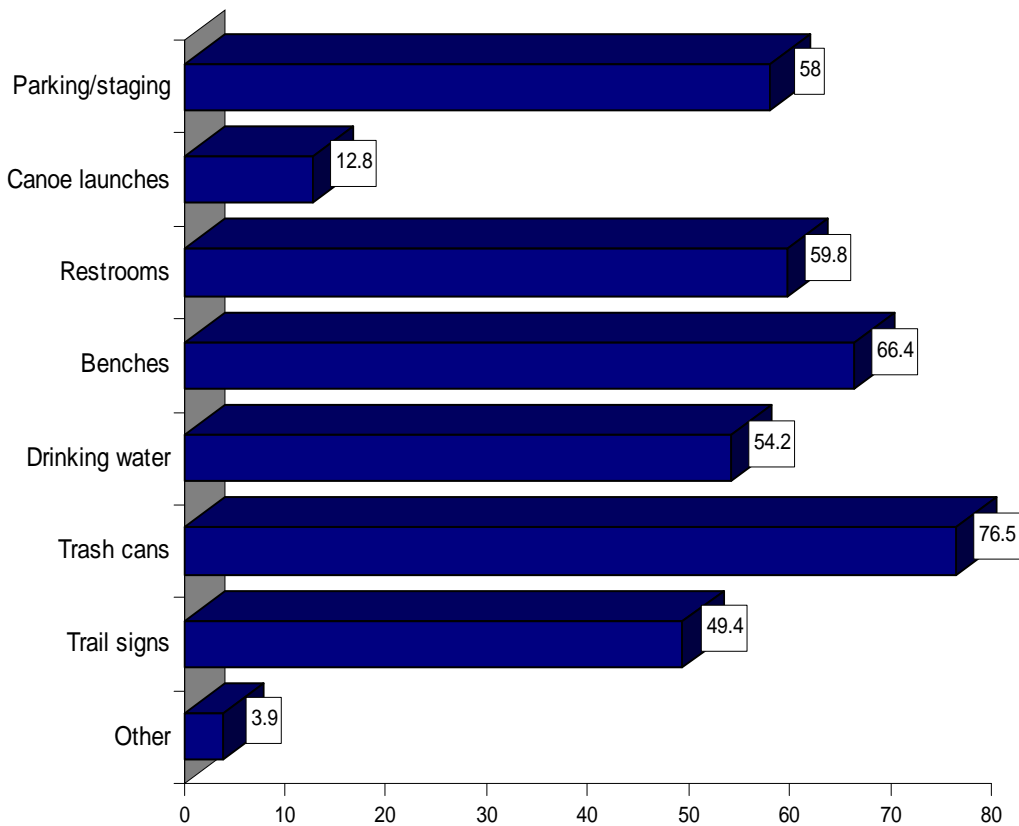

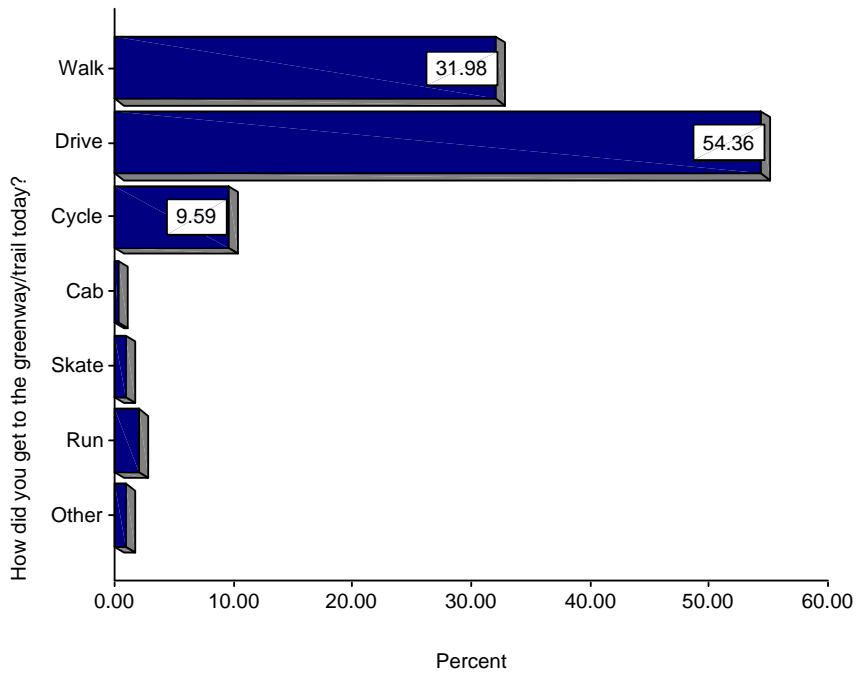

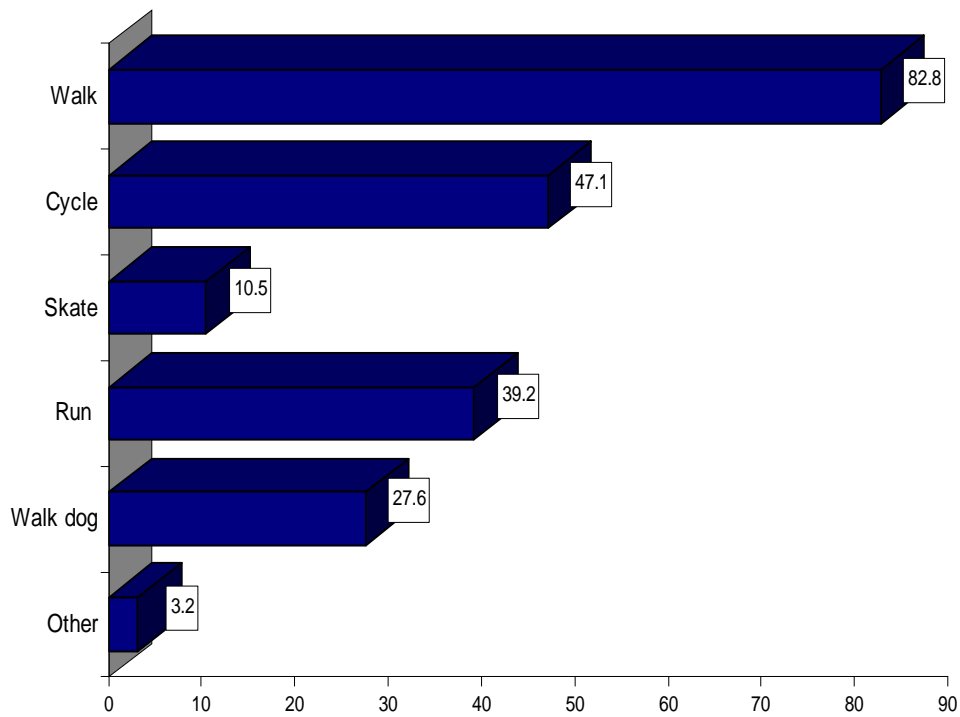

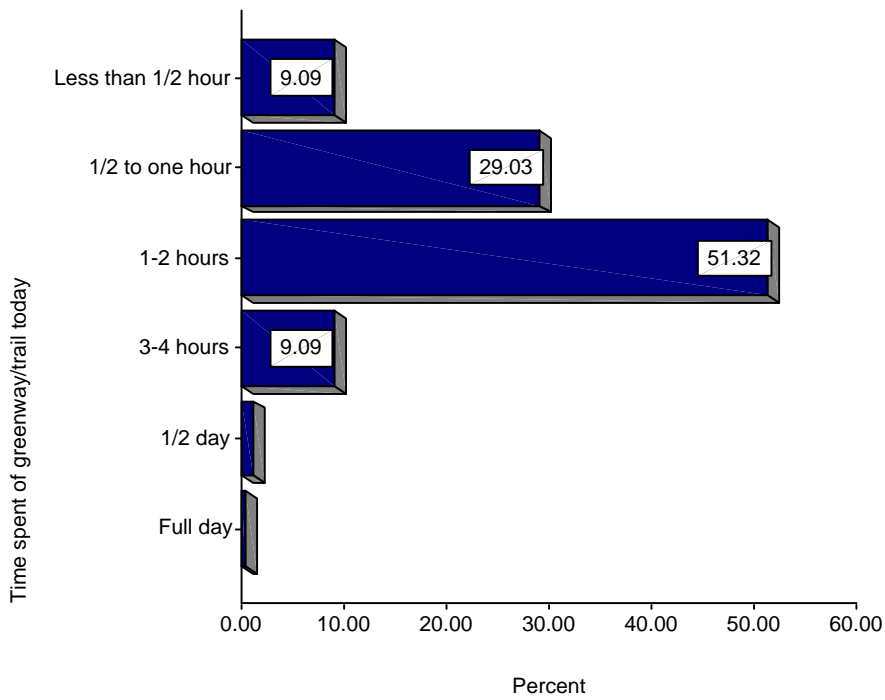

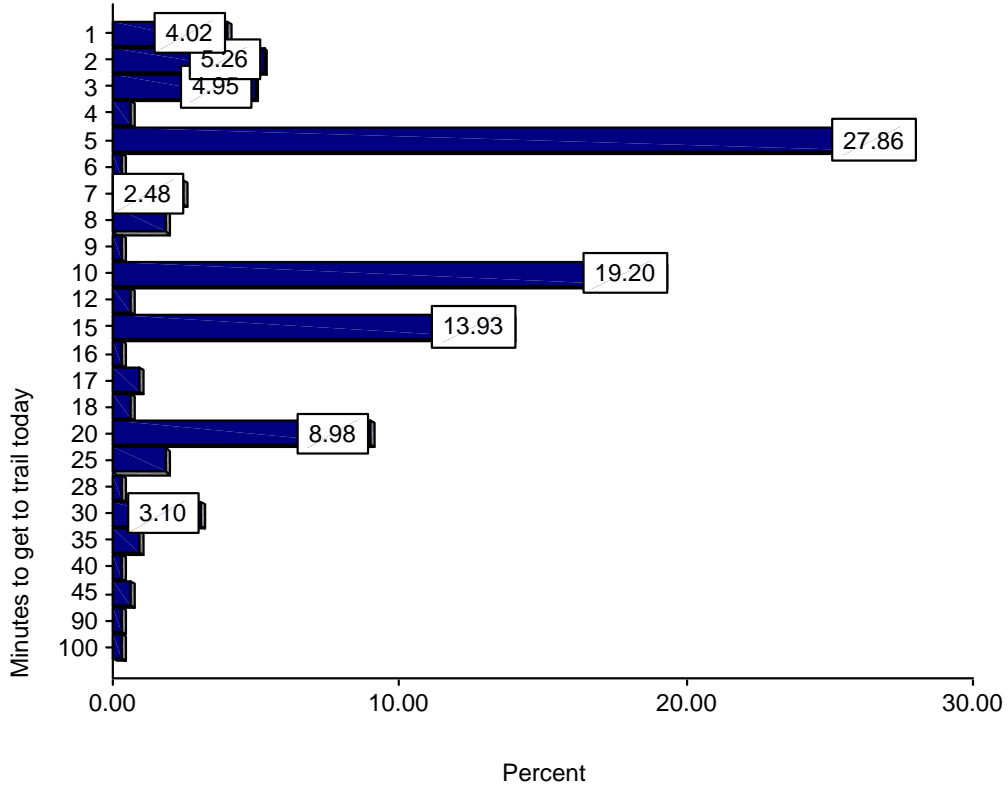

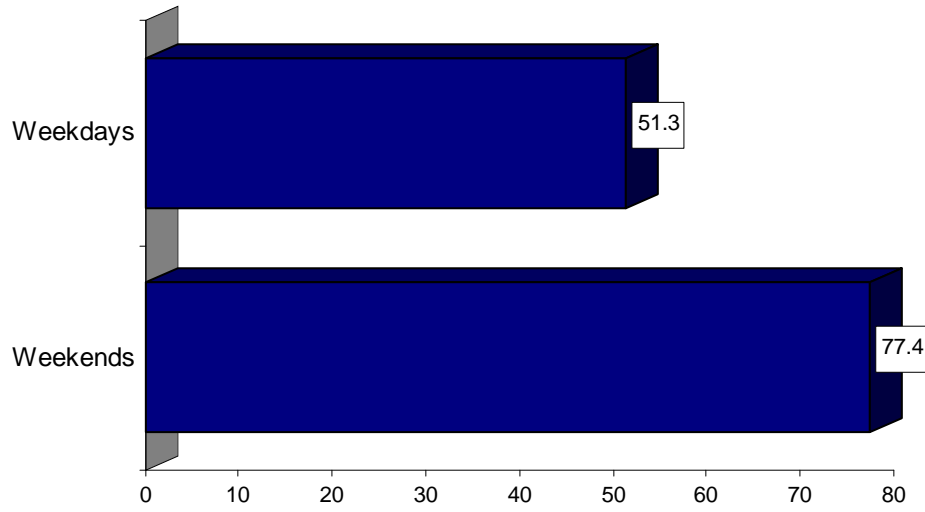

How long did it take you to get to the greenway/trail today? (minutes)?



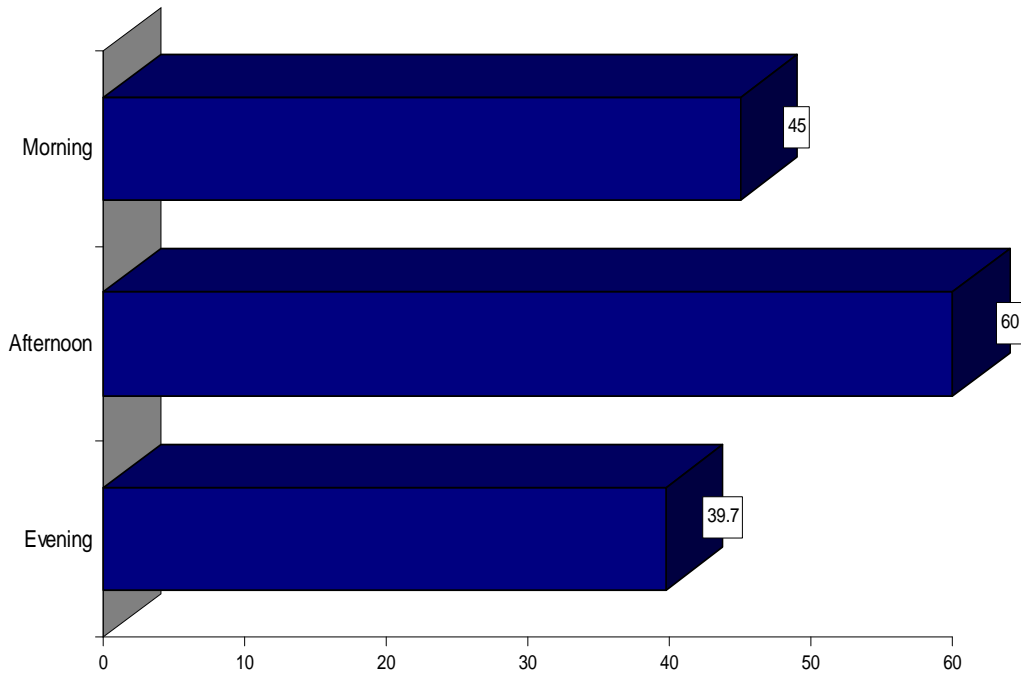

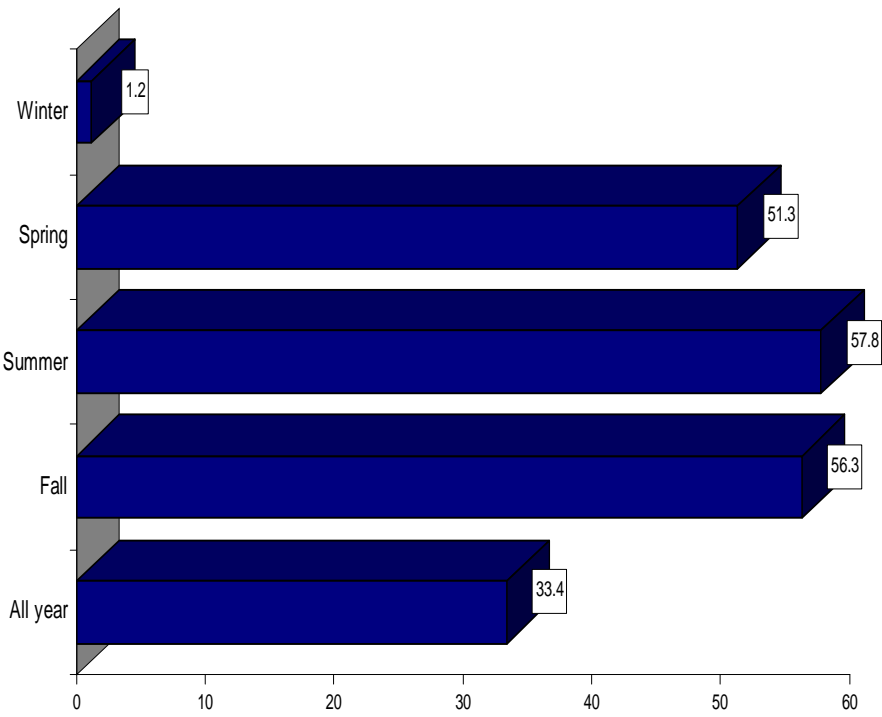
**What time of day do you use greenway/trails MOST OFTEN?

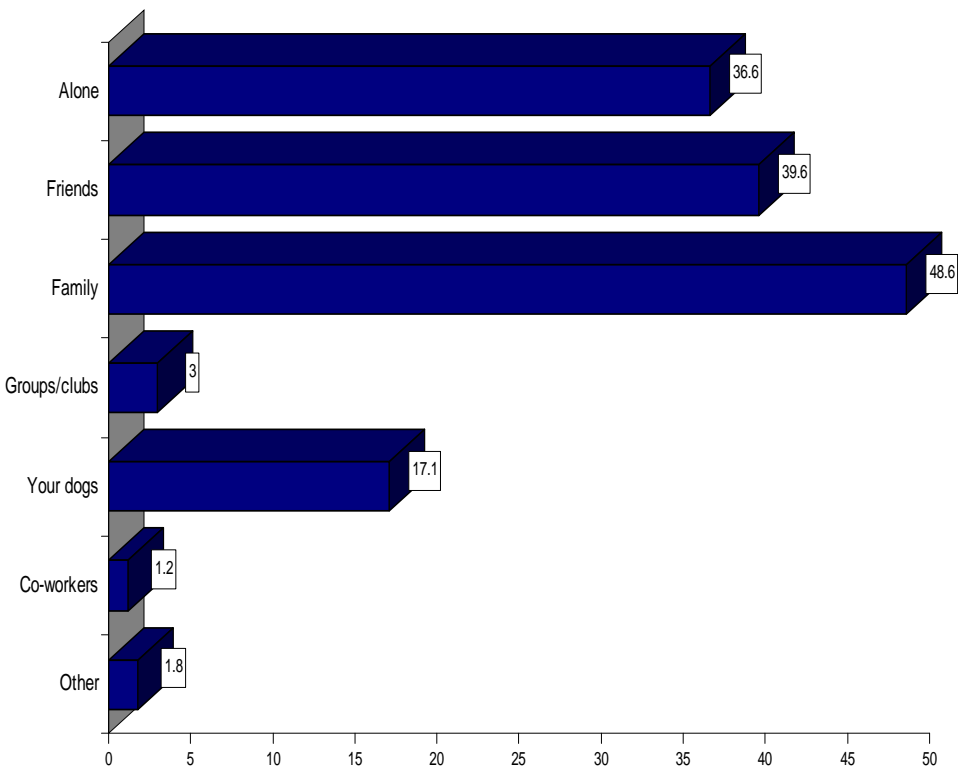

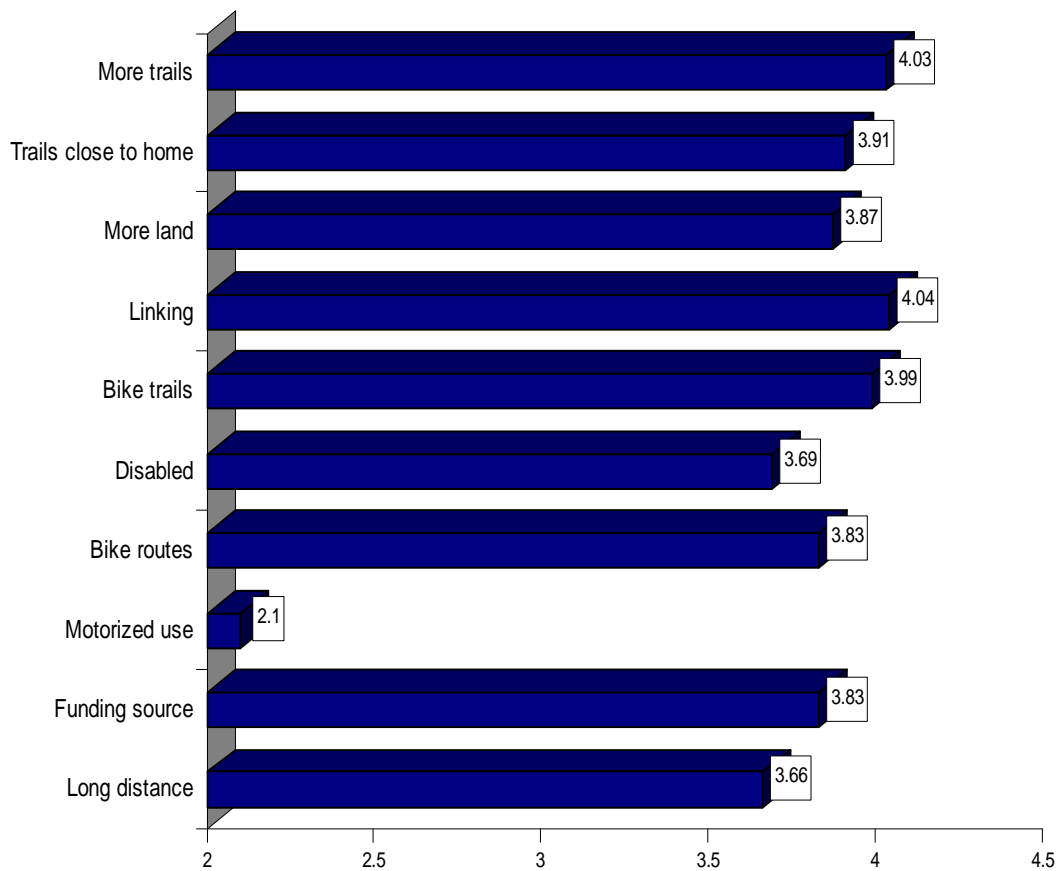

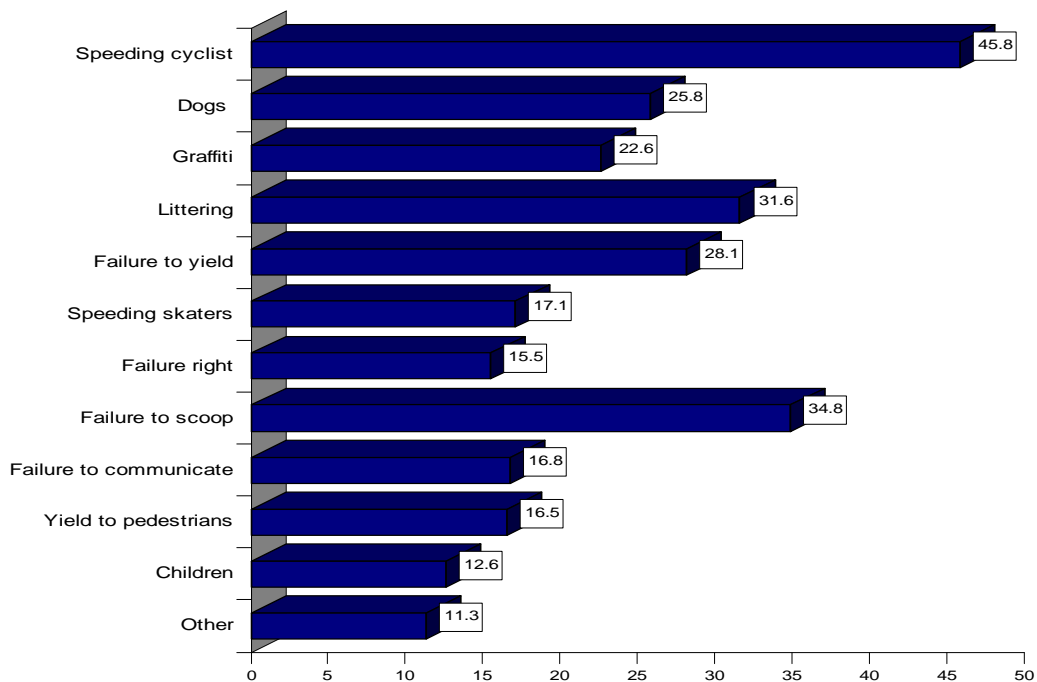

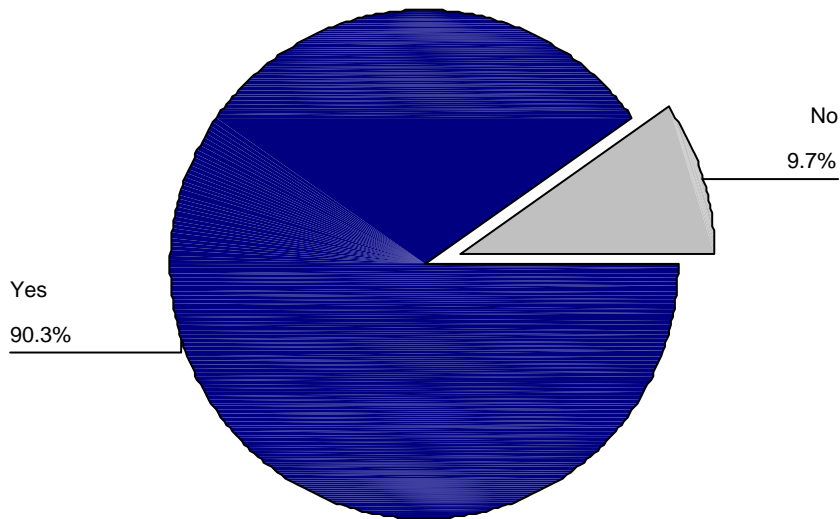

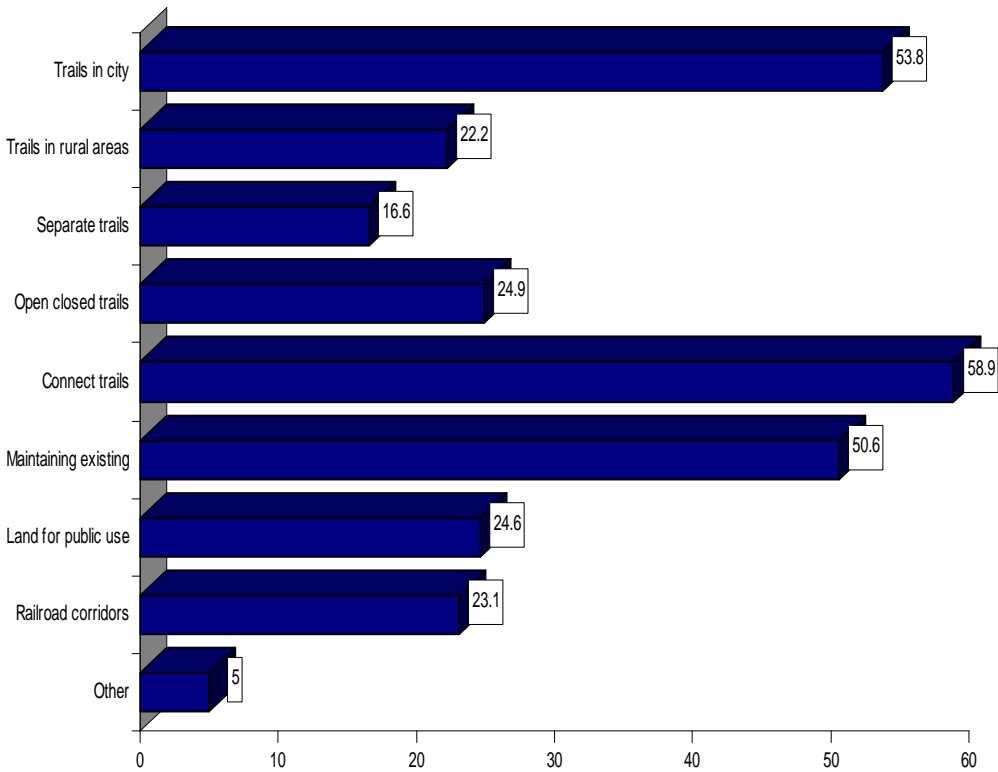
