Indy Do Day to feature 50 projects in 35 parks

INDIANAPOLIS – In partnership with Indy Do Day, Indy Parks is offering 50 volunteer projects in 35 different parks. This citywide community day hopes to inspire 20,000 Indianapolis residents to volunteer on September 29, 30 and October 1.

Park volunteers will paint, mulch, remove debris/weeds, resurface trails and playgrounds, and assist with other park and facility needs. Participating park locations include: Broad Ripple Park, Eagle Creek Park, Indy Urban Acres, Northwestway Park, and Sahn Park.

9/29 at 9 a.m.: Eagle Creek Park, 5901 Delong Rd.
Projects will occur at the Earth Discovery Center, administrative offices, shelters and swimming area.

9/30 at 9 a.m.: Roselawn Park, 5000 Roselawn Ave. The Indy Parks management team will paint, mulch, and pick up litter and debris.

10/1 at 10:30 a.m.: Franklin Township Community Park, 8801 E. Edgewood Ave. Members of Franklin Township Central High School's athletic teams will mulch, paint, and remove litter and weeds.
