## **Indy Parks to celebrate new playground at Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Park**

INDIANAPOLIS – In partnership with the City of Indianapolis and the Indianapolis Parks Foundation, Indy Parks is hosting a ribbon cutting ceremony at Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Park on Tuesday, November 15.

Mayor Joe Hogsett will join State Representative Greg Porter, City-County Councillor Vop Osili and students from the Center for Inquiry (IPS #27) to unveil the park's new playground and other enhancements.
