


Recurring Programs

Saturdays:

Nature Discovery Class, 1:30pm at the Earth Discovery Center. Stop by on Saturdays for a fun nature activity! Topics vary - possible activities include: nature hikes, pond life, simple crafts, and more! Free with park admission. Call 317-327-7148 for daily details.



Raptor Feeding Time, 2:30pm at the Ornithology Center. Join a naturalist at the Ornithology Center to watch us feed one or more of our live birds of prey. Feeding only take a few minutes so don't be late!

Sundays:

Sunday Morning Birdwalk, 9am-11am at the Ornithology Center. Join a group of new and experienced birders for a brisk morning bird walk!



Meets every Sunday morning, rain or shine. The walk is not geared specifically toward children, but they are welcome to attend.

Feeding Time, 1:30-2pm at the Earth Discovery Center. Watch as our educational reptiles, amphibians and other critters enjoy their lunch!

Meet A Raptor, 2:30-3pm at the Ornithology Center. Join a naturalist to discover the world of raptors! You will meet one (or more!) of our special live birds of prey and learn about what makes them raptors.

Wednesdays:

In Concert with Nature/Jazz on the Point, 6:30pm at the Marina. Bring a blanket, some chairs, or cruise in on your boat to enjoy some local folk or jazz tunes every Wednesday night June-August. Picnics are welcome and the concession stand remains open until 7pm. Free with park admission.



July Programs

To register for programs go to www.indyparks.org and enter the 5 digit course #. Free programs do not require registration.

July 4 (Tue) Earth Discovery Center, Ornithology Center, and Admin Office CLOSED. Park grounds open regular hours, restrooms available at Marina.

July 5 (Wed) Volunteer Coffee Talk, 8:30am at the Earth Discovery Center. Join us the first Wednesday of every month for an environmental presentation. A great chance to meet park volunteers and learn more about volunteer opportunities. Everyone is welcome! Free with park admission.

July 7 & 8 (Fri, Sat) Guided Full Moon Paddle, 7pm at the Marina. While the sun goes down, you'll receive basic paddling instructions and safety guidelines. July 8 (Sat) PACK THE PARKS! After 10am there will be free admission into Eagle Creek Park and into the swimming area (open 12pm-6pm) Both Nature Centers will have fun programs and activities running all day!


July 12 & 26 (Wed) Guided Sunset Paddle, 5:30pm at the Marina. Our knowledgeable & experienced guide will lead you on a leisurely, informative guided paddle. July 13 (Thur) Story Time on the Reservoir, 9:30am at the Earth Discovery Center. After reading a nature-themed story, participants will be able to visit stations at their own pace. Stations will vary but may include puppets, coloring pages, artifacts with a naturalist, or additional books. Program is best suited for preschool and kindergarten, but early elementary students are welcome to join. Free with park admission.

July 14 (Fri) Friday Night FrogWatch, 9-10:30pm starting at the Earth Discovery Center. Learn about frogs and frog calls, and visit a pond to search for the frogs themselves! Bring bright flashlights, wear old shoes/boots, and a rain jacket if raining. We will be around water at night, so be sure to register enough adults to supervise any children attending. \$5/person, ages 3+, course 12684
