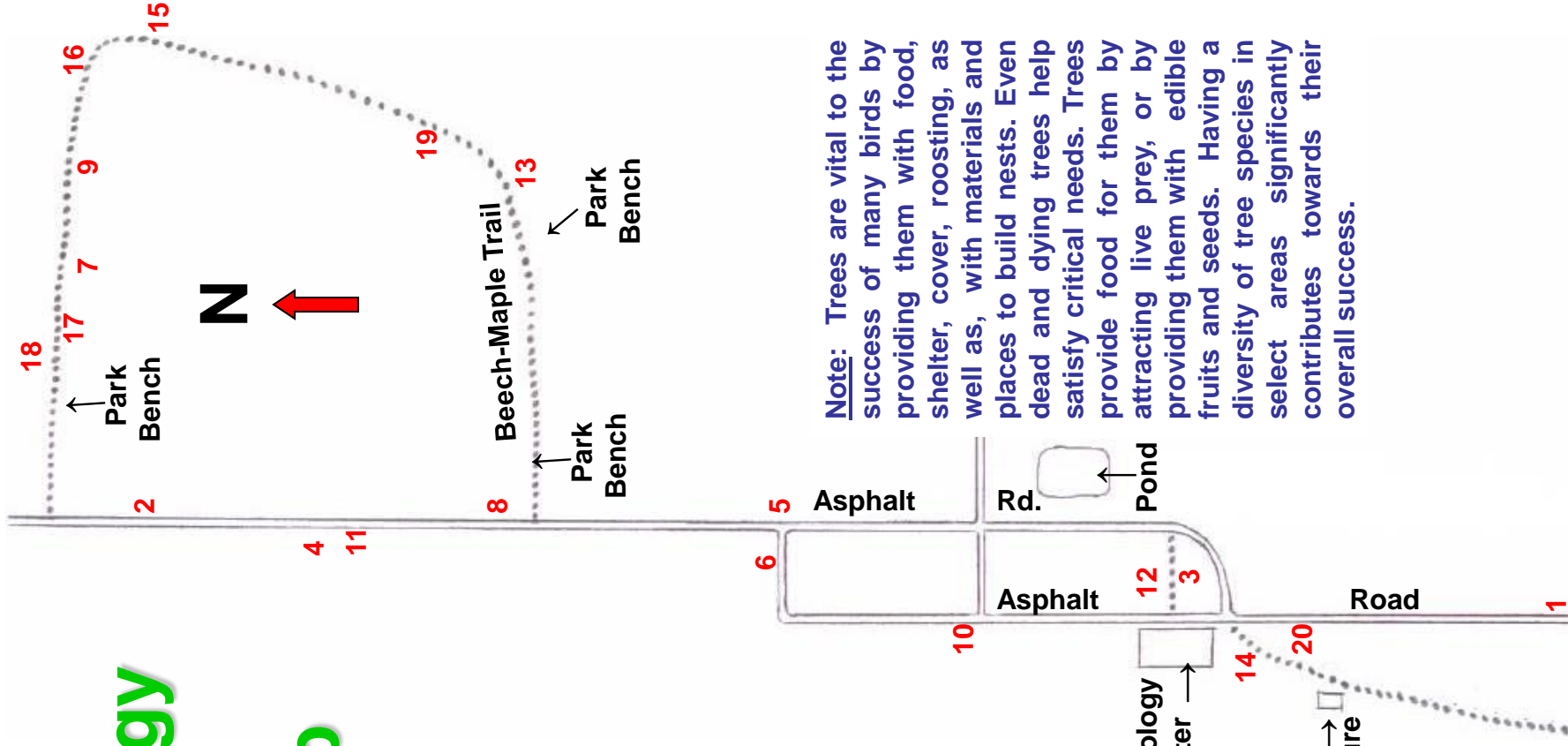


Ornithology Center Tree Map
