Broad Ripple Park, 327-7161

For CCZ pass, visit the Broad Ripple Park office at 1550 Broad Ripple Avenue.

Eagle Creek Park, 327-7110

For CCZ pass, visit the Eagle Creek Park office at 7840 W. 56th Street.

Paul Ruster Park, 327-0143

For CCZ pass, visit the Post Road Park office at 1313 S. Post Road.

Smock Bark Park, 888-0825

For CCZ pass, visit the Perry Park office at 451 E. Stop 11 Road.

Rules

- Keep your dog(s) on leash until you are inside the CCZ.
- While inside the CCZ, keep one leash per dog with you at all times.
- All dogs inside the CCZ must wear a current rabies tag and an Indy Parks Pooch Pass tag.
- Always clean up after your dog(s).
- Owners are to remain in the CCZ with their dogs at all times.
- You are responsible for the behavior of your dog(s).
- Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior are the responsibility of the owner.
- The CCZ is unsupervised. Use at your own risk. Indy Parks is not responsible for any injury or damage to you or your dog(s).

Pooch Pass Purchase

- Pooch Passes are based on the calendar year, Jan. 1 - Dec. 31.
- Pooch Passes consist of a tag for your dog and a gate access reader for you.
- There are a limited number of Pooch Passes available for each CCZ, a separate pass is required for each location.
- To purchase a Pooch Pass, visit the designated location with a copy of your dogs shot records showing current vaccinations for Rabies, Parvo, Distemper, and Bordetella.

Annual Pooch Pass

Jan. 1 - Dec. 31

\$75 and \$37.50 for each additional dog.

July 1 - Dec. 31

\$65 and \$32.50 for each additional dog.

Sept. 1 - Dec. 31

\$50 and \$25 for each additional dog.

Very Important Pooch (VIP) Pass

Good for all Indy Parks CCZ.

Jan. 1 - Dec. 31 - \$125.00

Additional fees:

\$10 tag replacement

\$10 gate access reader replacement

Indy Parks accepts cash, check payable to Indy Parks, Visa or Mastercard.

Etiquette

- Check all entrances before unleashing your dog, and ensure that park gates are closed behind you.
- Do not allow others to come in under your gate access reader.
- Indy Parks recommends that users not smoke or eat while in the CCZ.
- Be prepared to share your dog toys if you choose to bring them to the CCZ.
- Please do not allow dogs to dig.
- Indy Parks recommends that users bring no more than two dogs per person.
- Please be respectful of posted hours.
- Daily pass users, please drop gate access readers off in the designated drop box near the entrance to the dog park.
- In the event of an emergency that requires immediate attention, please call 911. To report non-emergencies, call 327-3811.
- Do not allow non-members access to the CCZ. Indy Parks may revoke membership for violating this rule.

Indy Parks strives to provides a fun, safe environment for you and your dog(s). However, by using this facility, you agree that you understand and assume all responsibility and liability for the risks of unleashing your dog(s) in the CCZ.

Children and Dogs

- The CCZ was created solely for dog owners to allow their dogs to be off leash.
- Please teach children how to behave around dogs before allowing children into the CCZ.
- Not all dogs are child-freindly, or accustomed to being around children.
- Children are easily knocked over by dogs.
- Dogs may nip at children in an attempt to herd them.
- Children who run and scream may attract the attention of a dog.
- Never allow your child to approach or pet a dog without the owner's presence or permission.
- Children are not permitted to use agility equipment.
