



Welcome to the City of Indianapolis, the home of Super Bowl XLVI. Below are some general safety tips to make your visit to our city a safe and memorable one.

Parking Scams:

Do not hesitate to ask questions. Ask for a receipt or tag for your dashboard. Ask who owns the lot and if there are time limits. Does the person look like they are a parking attendant?

Car Thefts:

Before leaving your vehicle make sure your car doors locked. Do not leave valuables in plain sight. Put them in the trunk.

Counterfeit merchandise:

Buy from licensed vendors. Headwear and jerseys are only manufactured by Reebok and “Mitchell & Ness”. Look for holograms that indicate official merchandise. The holograms are 1- inch in square and will have serial numbers. Also look for current logos. NFL- licensed merchandise will never favor one club over another clubs mark. All vendors must be licensed to sell authentic merchandise. Do not be afraid to ask to see the vendor’s permit.

Counterfeit/Stolen Tickets:

Counterfeit and stolen tickets will be out there. Buy from a licensed broker; be cautious of purchasing from a person off the street or Internet. If the offer sounds too good to be true, then it probably is. As an example, be aware of people who are selling game tickets under the going rate. Look for quality of paper stock, misspellings and logos that are off center. Be aware of people trying to sell an “up-graded” ticket. They may be attempting to sell you a counterfeit ticket to get your legitimate ticket. Make sure to safeguard your ticket.

Internet Scams:

This could be a potential robbery set up. Counterfeit sales will ask for money before sending, “Pay half now scams”. There are no “e-tickets” or printable game day tickets.

Fake Party or Events:

People selling tickets to free events. Make sure the event does not offer free admission before purchasing tickets to that event.

Pick pockets:

Put your valuables in your front pocket. Women make sure your purse is zipped; hold it close to your body and towards the front.
