Mr. Adams crashed his car into a parked car at 1600 N. Rural St. after he had been shot one block north of the accident scene. The shooting stemmed from an argument that the victim's passenger had with another man inside a nearby residence during a party. The shooter left the scene in a van immediately following the shooting. He was accompanied by two other men.

Witnesses described the shooter as a black male, age 38-39, 5ft 9in. tall and approximately 180 lbs. He had a lighter brown complexion and a scrappy beard with a mustache and low haircut. He wore a teal green "hoodie." Witnesses also described his accomplices. One was described as a black male, age 39-40 and 230 lbs. He had brown skin, short hair and a thin mustache, and he was wearing a jogging suit. The third man was a black male, age 38-40, 6 ft and 210 lbs with a brown complexion and a bald head. He wore blue jeans and a gray sweatshirt.

Mr. Valentine was discovered lying in his garage by his wife. It was determined that he had suffered a gunshot wound to the head. It is believed that several stray bullets passed through the wall of the garage, with one of the bullets striking the victim. The bullets were shot from the parking lot of a restaurant located at 3744 N. Keystone Av. where an argument had occurred.

At 11:00 pm, witnesses saw two vehicles speed away from the restaurant immediately after several shots were fired. The first vehicle was described as a dark colored Chevrolet Monte Carlo with tinted windows. It was occupied by a stocky to heavy-set black male wearing a white t-shirt. This car went south on North Keystone Avenue. The second car was described as a box-style Oldsmobile 98 with gold rims driven by a black male.
