PROJECT DETAILS

East 38th Street is a heavily traveled major thoroughfare, and has experienced severe deterioration due to drainage issues, and years of wear and tear.

Plans to repair 38th Street from Tacoma Avenue to Sherman Drive, includes the removal of old road pavement, base repairs to the street, and the resurfacing of approximately 5 lane miles. This resurfacing project is currently in design, and will begin its construction bidding process on August 2017. This bidding process will allow for a construction contractor to be selected.
