Office of Sustainability accepting nominations for Indianapolis Sustainability Awards

Awards program to take place as part of the Indianapolis Sustainability Summit

INDIANAPOLIS – On March 28th, the City of Indianapolis Office of Sustainability and IUPUI have partnered to host the city’s first-ever Indianapolis Sustainability Summit. This day-long gathering in IUPUI’s Campus Center will bring together residents and community leaders for a day of workshops, networking, and inspiring community action.

The summit will also feature the Indianapolis Sustainability Awards, designed to inspire innovation, showcase impact, reward leadership, and promote education around the principles of sustainability. Four awards will be given to highlight transformative work by a business, institution, nonprofit, and individual. A fifth award, the Knozone Clean Air Award, will recognize an individual, non-profit, or business that undertook an exceptional effort to improve local air quality. Any organization or individual is encouraged to submit a nomination, and self-nominations are welcome. Applications must be submitted to [this form](#) by 5 pm on February 19th, 2018.
