There will be a meeting of the Administration and Finance Committee of the City-County Council on **Tuesday, March 5, 2013, at 5:30p.m.** in **Room 260** of the City-County Building. It is anticipated that the following items may be considered by the Committee:

PROPOSAL NO. 289, 2012 - amends the Code to add a program for utilizing disability-owned business enterprises

PROPOSAL NO. 290, 2012 - amends the Code by adding a new Sec. 293-216 prohibiting fraternization under certain circumstances

PROPOSAL NO. 26, 2013 - authorizes the City to issue bonds in a maximum aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 to fund payments to two defendants to settle a civil lawsuit against IMPD Officer David Bisard and the City of Indianapolis on charges of negligence causing personal injury, neglect and intentional infliction of emotional distress

PROPOSAL NO. 58, 2013 - approves the issuance of special taxing district bonds of the Redevelopment District in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$28,500,000 for the purpose of refunding certain prior bonds

PROPOSAL NO. 54, 2013 - approves the Public Safety Support Agreement between the Capital Improvement Board of Managers and the Office of Finance and Management

PROPOSAL NO. 72, 2013 - amends the 2013 annual budget of the Capital Improvement Board of Managers to appropriate additional funds in the amount of \$11,630,000 in the Operating Fund for certain payments by the Board to the City for public safety in 2013
