PROPOSAL NO. 94, 2016 - appoints Doris Minton McNeill to the Metropolitan Board of Zoning Appeals, Division II

PROPOSAL NO. 137, 2016 - amends the Code to establish a community cat program, for additional requirements related to the care and treatment of animals, to clarify when an animal is at large, to clarify rabies vaccination requirements, and to update terminology and make other technical changes

PROPOSAL NO. 155, 2016 - requests the Metropolitan Development Commission to rename the 100 block of East St. Joseph Street as "Amos Brown Way"

PROPOSAL NO. 168, 2016 - designates the alleyway west of Allegheny Street, from Michigan Street to Lockerbie Street, as the Spurr Memorial Way

PROPOSAL NO. 170, 2016 - amends Special Resolution No. 64, 2015, which is an inducement resolution for the issuance of economic development revenue bonds in a redevelopment allocation area, which is now a co-development of Mapleton-Fall Creek Development Corporation and Merchants Affordable Housing Corp in an amount not to exceed \$17,000,000 to provide a portion of the cost for acquisition, construction and equipping of a new multi-housing facility consisting of 114 residential units for low and moderate-income families and individuals located at 507 East 29th Street (District 9)
