ON THE 2<sup>ND</sup> FLOOR OF THE CITY-COUNTY BUILDING, 200 E. WASHINGTON STREET, INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA IN THE DR. BEURT R. SERVAAS PUBLIC ASSEMBLY ROOM. THE MEMBERS OF THE MARION COUNTY INCOME TAX COUNCIL ARE THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY-COUNTY COUNCIL OF INDIANAPOLIS AND MARION COUNTY, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEECH GROVE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF SOUTHPORT, AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SPEEDWAY.
