PROPOSAL NO. 248, 2016 - amends the Code by adding a new chapter regarding wage enforcement

PROPOSAL NO. 335, 2016 - adds a new section to the Code establishing the space allocation committee

PROPOSAL NO. 341, 2016 - amends the Code regarding the criteria for designated memorial areas

PROPOSAL NO. 346, 2016 - amends Chapter 903 of the Code to include pedal pubs in the regulation of pedal cabs

PROPOSAL NO. 364, 2016 - approves a transfer and appropriation of \$20,000,000 from the City Rainy Day Fund to the 2016 Budget of the Department of Public Works (Transportation General Fund) for the maintenance and rehabilitation of local roads and streets

There will be a meeting of the Public Works Committee of the City-County Council on **Thursday, November 3, 2016 at 5:30 p.m.** in **Room 260** of the City-County Building. It is anticipated that the following items may be considered by the Committee:

PROPOSAL NO. 334, 2016 - amends Sec. 441-324 of the Code regarding school zones

PROPOSAL NO. 361, 2016 - authorizes a transfer of \$1,170,000 and appropriates an additional \$2,708,000 in the 2016 Budget of the Department of Public Works (Consolidated County, Transportation General, Parks General, and Solid Waste Disposal Funds) to cover vehicle maintenance and equipment, Safer Routes to School program supplies, additional mowing cycles, and to meet solid waste contractual obligations

PROPOSAL NO. 362, 2016 - authorizes intersection controls on Garfield Drive at Hervey Street and Ringgold Avenue (District 21)

PROPOSAL NO. 363, 2016 - approving of the issuance of special taxing district bonds of the Metropolitan Thoroughfare District of Marion County in an amount not to exceed \$24,600,000 for the purpose of procuring funds to be applied to the costs of certain road and street improvements and the purchase of certain equipment, together with incidental expenses incurred in connection with or on account of the issuance of the bonds
