PROPOSAL NO. 407, 2016 - appoints Mark Webster to the Board of Public Health and Safety

PROPOSAL NO. 456, 2016 - reappoints Nate Davis to the Early Intervention Planning Council

PROPOSAL NO. 512, 2016 - reappoints Johnie Underwood to the Reuben Engagement Center Board

PROPOSAL NO. 15, 2017 - approves a transfer and appropriation of \$200,000 in the 2017 Budget of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department (IMPD General Fund) for personal protective and safety equipment for police officers, funded by a transfer of accrued interest from the City's Fiscal Stability Fund

PROPOSAL NO. 16, 2017 - approves a transfer and appropriation of \$400,000 in the 2017 Budget of the Office of Public Health and Safety (Consolidated County General Fund) for the crime prevention grants program, funded by the transfer of accrued interest from the City's Rainy Day Fund

PROPOSAL NO. 35, 2017 - confirms the mayor's appointment of Bryan Roach as the chief of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department
