There will be a meeting of the Metropolitan Development Committee of the City-County Council on **Wednesday, May 27, 2009**, at **5:30 p.m.** in **Room 260** of the City-County Building. It is anticipated that the following items may be considered by the Committee:

PROPOSAL NO. 187, 2009 - approves an appropriation of \$42,100 in the 2009 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development (Federal Grants Fund) to fund various historic preservation commission initiatives in the Irvington neighborhood, funded by a Preserve America Grant through the U.S. Department of Interior

PROPOSAL NO. 188, 2009 - approves an appropriation of \$892,344 in the 2009 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development (State Grants and Redevelopment Funds) to fund the repayment of a revolving loan on the Riverside Brownfield project, extension of Intech Boulevard in a Certified Technology Park, and to assist with site improvements at the Lafayette Square Mall consistent with Community Revitalization Enhancement District (CRED) guidelines

PROPOSAL NO. 189, 2009 - approves an appropriation of \$7,118,000 in the 2009 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development (Federal Grants Fund) to provide rental assistance, security and utility deposit payments, housing search and placement and other activities associated with homelessness prevention and to develop and provide affordable rental housing and create economic opportunities primarily for people with low-to moderate incomes, financed by federal stimulus funds for homelessness prevention and community development block grants (CDBG) and an available line of credit rollover in the HOME fund with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

PROPOSAL NO. 190, 2009 - approves an appropriation of \$24,236,000 in the 2009 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development (Federal Grants Fund) to purchase foreclosed and abandoned housing and to develop, rehabilitate, rent or resell such housing in order to stabilize neighborhoods and stem the decline of housing values, financed by Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as part of the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP)

PROPOSAL NO. 172, 2009 – authorizes one-way restrictions on Waldemere Avenue and Alley 1175 South (District 13)

PROPOSAL NO. 197, 2009 - authorizes a multi-way stop at the intersection of Bolton Avenue and Lowell Avenue (District 21)

PROPOSAL NO. 198, 2009 - authorizes intersection controls at Lakeland Trails Boulevard and Ridge Harvest Lane and Lakeland Trails Boulevard and Silver Lake Place (District 25)

PROPOSAL NO. 199, 2009 - authorizes intersection controls in the Greythorne subdivision, Sections 2 and 3 (District 25)

PROPOSAL NO. 200, 2009 - authorizes intersection controls in the Mayfair Village subdivision, Section 1 (District 21)

PROPOSAL NO. 201, 2009 - authorizes a change in parking meters on the south side of Washington Street by the new JW Marriott Hotel being constructed on the southwest corner of Washington and West Streets (Districts 15 and 19)

PROPOSAL NO. 202, 2009 - amends Chapter 511, Air Pollution Control, of the Revised Code to formally codify noxious odor emission standards and to regulate noxious odor emissions in Indianapolis and Marion County
