There will be a meeting of the Public Safety and Criminal Justice Committee of the City-County Council on **Wednesday, January 26, 2005**, at **5:00 p.m.** in room **260**. It is anticipated that the following items may be considered by the Committee:

PROPOSAL NO. 28, 2005 - confirms the Marion County Public Defender Board's nomination of David Cook as Marion County Chief Public Defender

PROPOSAL NO. 29, 2005 - approves an increase of \$13,900 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion County Sheriff (State & Federal Grants Fund) to fund overtime and fringe expenses for task force projects

PROPOSAL NO. 30, 2005 - approves an increase of \$14,882 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion County Sheriff (State & Federal Grants Fund) to fund purchase of supplies and services for the Bomb Vehicle

PROPOSAL NO. 31, 2005 - approves an increase of \$10,000 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion Superior Court, Juvenile Division (State and Federal Grants Fund), to continue to fund drug court costs

PROPOSAL NO. 32, 2005 - approves a transfer of \$92,500 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion County Justice Agency (Marion County Drug Free Fund) to pay approved grant expenses for Marion Superior Court and Marion County Prosecutor

PROPOSAL NO. 676, 2004 - amends the Code to require that egress from exit stairwells not be restricted on intervening floors
