<u>PROPOSAL NO. 625, 2004</u> - a special resolution concerning the remarketing of the City of Indianapolis Economic Development Revenue Bonds, series 1994 (Knob in the Woods project) in the aggregate principal amount of \$8,9000,000 (District 2)

<u>PROPOSAL NO. 572, 2004</u> – approves an increase of \$796,000 in the 2004 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development, Division of Planning (Non-Lapsing Federal Grants Fund), to pay for an Alternative Analysis study to further investigate rapid transit and a Comprehensive Operation Analysis to investigate local transit systems, financed by a grant from the Federal Transit Administration

PROPOSAL NO. 573, 2004 — approves an increase of \$949,000 in the 2004 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development, Community Development Division (Federal Grants and Redevelopment General Fund), to cover development costs, infrastructure needs, and acquisition of the final properties at Fall Creek Place, financed by a grant from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, program income through the use of Community Development Block Grant funds and Redevelopment General Fund balance

<u>PROPOSAL NO. 574, 2004</u> - approves a decrease of \$352,523 in the 2004 Budget of the Department of Metropolitan Development, Community Development Division, for the purpose of increasing the fund balance in the Solid Waste Collection Fund
