PROPOSAL NO. 260, 2005 - appoints Kent Burrow to the Cable Franchise Board

PROPOSAL NO. 259, 2005 - appoints Robert J. Shula to the Metropolitan Development Commission

PROPOSAL NO. 756, 2004 - amends the Code establishing a Marion County Early Intervention Planning Council

PROPOSAL NO. 778, 2004 - appoints Doris A. McNeill to the Citizens Advisory Committee for Wayne Township Comprehensive Plan

PROPOSAL NO. 165, 2005 - opposes the efforts to privatize Social Security

PROPOSAL NO. 193, 2005 - endorses Senate Bill 307, which creates a bipartisan commission to study consolidation of government services in Marion County

PROPOSAL NO. 258, 2005 - increases the tax rates of the county food and beverage tax, the county admissions tax, the county supplemental auto rental excise tax, and the county innkeeper's tax, all as authorized by statute

There will be a meeting of the Public Safety and Criminal Justice Committee of the City-County Council on **Wednesday, May 25, 2005**, at **5:00 p.m.** in Room **260**. It is anticipated that the following items may be considered by the Committee:

PROPOSAL NO. 243, 2005 - approves an increase of \$10,500 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion Superior Court (State and Federal Grants Fund) for interpreter services, funded by a grant from the State of Indiana, Indiana Supreme Court, Foreign Language Interpreter Grant

PROPOSAL NO. 244, 2005 - approves a transfer of \$15,047 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion Superior Court (State and Federal Grants Fund) to transfer Salaries to Supplies and Other Services and Charges to provide for expenses for Drug Treatment

PROPOSAL NO. 245, 2005 - approves a transfer of \$61,523 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion Superior Court (State and Federal Grants Fund) to close out Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant IV and V and to pay remaining expenses

PROPOSAL NO. 246, 2005 - approves a transfer of \$516 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion Superior Court (State and Federal Grants Fund) to transfer Salaries to Other Services and Charges to provide bus passes for Community Work Services Crew

PROPOSAL NO. 247, 2005 - approves a transfer of \$1,806 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion Superior Court (State and Federal Grants Fund) to move supply money from Community Court grant to allow re-posting of operating expense

PROPOSAL NO. 248, 2005 - approves a transfer of \$60,000 in the 2005 Budget of the Community Corrections Agency (State and Federal Grants Fund) to pay for facilitation services as criminal justice officials redesign the Juvenile Justice System, funded by a grant from the Department of Corrections

PROPOSAL NO. 249, 2005 - approves a transfer of \$420,000 in the 2005 Budget of the Public Defender Agency (County General Fund) to transfer funds to cover supply costs and increased costs for death penalty cases
