There will be a meeting of the Public Safety and Criminal Justice Committee of the City-County Council on **Wednesday, April 13, 2005**, at **5:00 p.m.** in Room **260**. It is anticipated that the following items may be considered by the Committee:

PROPOSAL NO. 111, 2005 approves a transfer of \$21,900 in the 2005 Budget of the Marion Superior Court (State & Federal Grants Fund) to pay expenses for marketing displays, van graphics, website upgrades, rent, utilities & maintenance costs for the Community Court, funded by a grant from Department of Justice, Indiana Criminal Justice Institute

PROPOSAL NO. 144, 2005 - reappoints Katy Behan to the Citizens Police Complaint Board
