CITY-COUNTY SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. _____, 2010

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE electing to fund the operations of the public communications system and computer facilities district in 2011 with County Option Income Tax (COIT) Revenues.

WHEREAS, IC 36-8-15-7 provides for the creation of the Consolidated City of Indianapolis and Marion County Public Safety Communications System and Computer Facilities District ("District") to provide and maintain modern, dependable, and efficient public safety communications systems within the district for the purpose of promoting the expeditious delivery of public services to the residents and taxpayers throughout the district in order to assure the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare to provide computers for the efficient functioning of governmental offices for the benefit of the residents and taxpayers throughout the district; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-8-15-19(b) provides that the city-county council may elect to fund the operation of a public safety communications system and computer facilities special taxing district from part of the certified distribution the county is to receive during a particular calendar year under IC 6-3.5-6-17; and

WHEREAS, to make such an election for 2011, the city-county council, prior to September 1, 2010, must pass an ordinance specifying the amount of the certified distribution to be used to fund the District; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY-COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS AND OF MARION COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The city-county council hereby elects to fund the operations of the District in 2011 from part of the certified distribution the county is to receive under IC 6-3.5-6-17.

SECTION 2. A certified distribution in an amount not to exceed \$9,900,000 is to be used for the following purposes:

- (1) the provision and maintenance of modern, dependable, and efficient public safety communications systems within the district for the purpose of promoting the expeditious delivery of public services to the residents and taxpayers throughout the district in order to assure the public health, safety, morals and general welfare and
- (2) the provision of computers for the efficient functioning of governmental offices for the benefit of the residents and taxpayers throughout the district.

SECTION 3. Upon adoption, the clerk of the council shall immediately forward a copy of this ordinance to the county auditor.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption and compliance with IC 36-3-4-14.
