CITY-COUNTY GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. , 2005

A GENERAL ORDINANCE amending the "Revised Code of the Consolidated City and County," Sec. 621-122, Stopping, standing or parking prohibited at all times on certain designated streets, and Sec. 621-125, Stopping, standing and parking prohibited at designated locations on certain days and hours.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY-COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS AND OF MARION COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The "Revised Code of the Consolidated City and County," specifically, Sec. 621-122, Stopping, standing or parking prohibited at all times on certain designated streets, be and the same is hereby amended by the deletion of the following, to wit:

Forty-sixth Street, on the south side, from Boulevard Place to a point
30 feet east of Carrollton Avenue;

SECTION 2. That the Revised Code of the Consolidated City and County, Indianapolis/Marion County, Indiana, specifically Sec. 621-122, Stopping, standing or parking prohibited at all times on certain designated streets, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition of the following, to wit:

Forty-sixth Street, on the south side, from Boulevard Place to Keystone Avenue;

SECTION 3. That the Revised Code of the Consolidated City and County, Indianapolis/Marion County, Indiana, specifically Sec. 621-125 Stopping, standing or parking prohibited at designated locations on certain days and hours, be, and the same is hereby amended by the deletion of the following, to wit:

*From 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and
from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.*

Forty-sixth Street, on both sides, from first alley east of College Avenue to Erie Avenue;

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption and compliance with IC 36-3-4-14.
