

**MARION COUNTY, INDIANA ELECTION BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 06-18**

WHEREAS, the Marion County Election Board (the "Election Board") is charged with the responsibility of conducting elections in Marion County; and

WHEREAS, Title 3 of the Indiana Code (the "Election Code") governs the operations of elections in Indiana; and

WHEREAS, IC 3-11-10-26.3 allows a county election board, by unanimous resolution approved by all its members, to authorize the Circuit Court Clerk to establish satellite offices in the county where voters may cast absentee ballots before an absentee ballot board; and

WHEREAS, the Election Board has, in consultation with the major political parties in Marion County, determined that satellite voting shall be available as follows:


- Friday, October 26 through Sunday, November 4, 2018:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Marion County Election Board as follows:


1. The Election Board unanimously declares that, pursuant to IC 3-11-10-26.3, a voter may cast an absentee ballot: (a) at the satellite voting locations, and (b) during the dates and times specified in this Resolution.
2. The Director of Elections is hereby authorized to take such actions and to employ and appoint such individuals as necessary and appropriate to carry out the provisions of and responsibilities imposed by this Resolution.
3. That this resolution expires January 1 of the year immediately after the year in which the resolution is adopted.

ADOPTED AND APPROVED at a meeting of the Marion County Election Board on the 25th day of July, 2018.


