2008 Campaign Finance Reporting Schedule*

Political Action Committees, Regular Party Committees and State and Local Candidate's Committees (Except for Statewide Candidates)

Only candidates on the ballot in 2008 file pre-primary, supplemental and pre-election reports. For example, a person running for County Coronor would file these three reports because the office appears on the ballot in 2008. However, a City-County Councillor would NOT file these three reports because the office does NOT appear on the ballot in 2008. In Marion County, Councillors were elected in 2007.

All candidates are required to file an annual report. Pay special attention to the filing period for those offices on the ballot in 2008 versus offices NOT on the ballot.

2008 Pre-Primary Report

- Reporting Period – 1/1/08 – 4/11/08
- Filing Deadline – 4/18/08
 - All State, Local, and County candidates (except candidates for statewide office) on 2008 Primary Election Ballot
 - All PACs, and Regular Party Committees

2008 Primary Election Supplemental Report

- Reporting Period – 4/12/08 – 5/4/08
- Filing Deadline – No Later than 48 hours After Receipt of "Large Contributions"
 - Candidates on 2008 Primary Election Ballot Only

2008 Pre-Election Report

- Reporting Period – 4/12/08 – 10/10/08
- Filing Deadline – 10/17/08
 - All Candidates (except candidates for statewide office) on 2008 General Election Ballot
 - All PACs, and Regular Party Committees

2008 General Election Supplemental Report

- Reporting Period – 10/11/08 – 11/2/08
- Filing Deadline – Later than 48 hours After Receipt of "Large Contributions"
 - Candidates (except for candidates for statewide office) on 2008 General Election Ballot ONLY

2008 Annual Report

- Reporting Period – 10/11/08 – 12/31/08
 - 1/1/2008 – 12/31/2008 if no previous reports filed in 2008 because the office was not on the ballot.
- Filing Deadline – 1/21/09
 - All Candidates, PACs, and Legislative Caucus Committees
- Filing Deadline – 3/2/09
 - All Regular Party Committees

U.S. Congressional Candidate Committee

Candidates running for federal offices like U.S. Senate or House do NOT file with the Marion County Election Board or the Indiana Election Division. These reports can be found at the Federal Election Commission's online database – www.FEC.gov.

2008 Quarterly Reports

- April Quarterly Reporting Period – 1/1/08 – 3/31/08
 - April Quarterly Filing Deadline – 4/15/08
- July Quarterly Reporting Period – 4/1/08 – 6/30/08
 - July Quarterly Filing Deadline – 7/15/08
- October Quarterly Reporting Period – 7/1/08 – 9/30/08
 - October Quarterly Filing Deadline – 10/15/08
- Year-End Quarterly Reporting Period – 10/1/08 – 12/31/08
 - Year-End Quarterly Filing Deadline – 1/31/09
 - Note: Year-End filing deadline falls on a weekend. Filing deadlines are not extended for weekends or federal holidays.
- Quarterly reports are required for all committees. The following reports are required only in candidate runs in the election.

2008 Pre-Primary Report

- Pre-Primary Reporting Period – 1/1/08 – 4/16/08
 - Pre-Primary Mailing Deadline – 4/21/08
 - Pre-Primary Filing Deadline – 4/24/08
- Note: For candidates running in the election, the pre-primary report replaces the April Quarterly Report.

2008 Pre-Primary 48-Hour Notice Supplemental Report

- Pre-Primary 48-Hour Notice Supplemental Reporting Period – 4/17/08 – 5/3/08
 - 48-Notices are required if the campaign committee receives any contribution of \$1,000 or more per source, during the applicable period.

2008 Pre-General Report

- Pre-General Reporting Period – 10/1/08 – 10/15/08
 - Pre-General Filing Deadline – 10/23/08

2008 Post-General Report

- Post-General Reporting Period – 10/16/08 – 11/24/08
 - Post-General Filing Deadline – 12/4/08
 - Note: Year-End Quarterly Reporting Period is from 11/25/08 through 12/31/08 for candidates filing Pre-General and Post-General Reports.
