Northside home invasion suspect charged in Nov. 27 murder

Eleven now charged in two home invasions; Adrian Anthony charged in recent murder

(Indianapolis, Ind.) – Marion County Prosecutor Terry Curry announced today that Adrian Anthony has been charged with Murder and Robbery in the fatal shooting that took place November 27, 2013, on North Gray Street. Anthony was arrested Saturday in connection with the October home invasions and assaults on Spring Mill Road and E. 79th Street.

Anthony and Christopher Bell have been charged in connection with the shooting death of Robbie Gibson on last Wednesday, November 27. Robbie Gibson and his brother Ron Gibson were working at a residence on North Gray Street when they were approached by two suspects who displayed a handgun and demanded money. It is alleged that Anthony fatally shot Robbie Gibson, and Anthony and Bell are thus both charged with Murder and Robbery (A Felony). Anthony is also charged with Carrying a Handgun without a License (A Misdemeanor).

Anthony had been arrested on Saturday evening in connection with the October home invasion cases. With his arrest, eleven suspects have now been arrested and charged in connection with those home invasions. Four suspects have been charged in both crimes.

"The IMPD detectives and our deputy prosecutors should be commended for their diligent and painstaking work in investigating and charging these crimes," Marion County Prosecutor Terry Curry said. "It is our hope that the arrests of those alleged to be involved in these crimes will bring some reassurance to the public."

Five suspects have been charged with 40 total counts each for their alleged involvement the North Spring Mill Road incident on October 24, 2013. The charges include multiple counts of Burglary (A Felony), Criminal Deviate Conduct (B Felony), Carjacking (B Felony), Criminal Confinement (B Felony), Robbery (B Felony), Battery (C Felony), Forgery (C Felony), Intimidation (C Felony) and Sexual Battery (C Felony). The cases of the following five defendants have been assigned to Criminal Court 6.

PAGE 2 / HOME INVASION SUSPECT CHARGED IN MURDER

Five suspects have been charged with 35 total counts each for their alleged involvement in the East 79th Street incident on October 29, 2013. The charges include multiple counts of Rape (A Felony), Criminal Deviate Conduct (A Felony), Carjacking (B Felony), Criminal Confinement (B Felony), Robbery (B Felony), Battery (C Felony), Intimidation (C Felony) and Battery by Body Waste (A Misdemeanor). The cases of the following five defendants have been assigned to Criminal Court 4.

- Demetre Brown
- Alexander Dupree
- Michael Pugh
- Trae Spells

Five additional suspects are charged in connection with the North Spring Mill Road incident on October 24, 2013. The cases of the following five defendants have been assigned to Criminal Court 6.

- Amber Deckard: Charged with Assisting a Criminal (C Felony), Auto Theft (D Felony) and Theft (D Felony).
- James Phillips: Charged with Assisting a Criminal (C Felony) and Theft (D Felony).
- Ira Marsh: Charged with Assisting a Criminal (C Felony) and Theft (D Felony).
- Jade Lundy: Charged with Assisting a Criminal (C Felony) and Theft (D Felony).
- Renee Washington: Charged with Assisting a Criminal (C Felony) and Theft (D Felony).

A charge of a crime is merely an accusation, and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
